Begin at N. W. cor. of the Johnson B. Goff. D. L. C #38
T. 23 S. R. 7 W. which I establish from original B. I.
 Thence East, on North boundary of Cl #38, 49.50 chains
 for N. E. cor. of Cl #38 where I find oak marked
 C38 23 S. 7 W. blown down which I identify as
 original corner for Cl #38. Other B. I. obliterated
 I mark a Fir 8" diam, C. 38 C. S. B. I. N. 79° 10' E 24
 links and a Fir 6" diam, C. 38 C. S. B. I. N. 58° 10' W 23
 links for new B. I. for N. E. cor. of Cl. #38.
 Thence South on East boundary of Cl #38 13.15
 chains to interior cor. Cl #38 which I establish
 from Original B. I.
 Thence East on N. Boundary of Cl #38, 52.00 chains
 to point in N. boundary of Cl #38, 9.00 chains West
 of N. E. cor. of Cl #38; thence south 20.00
 chains; to corner where I set a post from
 which a W. Oak 18" diam marked C. S. B. I. bears
 S 84° E 74 links and a W. Oak 30" diam, marked
 C. S. B. I. bears S 8° E. 160 links; thence East 20.37
 chains intersect Sec. line ^{at N. E. corner of Sec #5, Sec. 34} between Sec 34 and 35.
 Set Post from which a Fir 20" diam marked
 C. S. B. I. bears N. 8 1/4° E 34 lks and a Fir
 20" diam, marked C. S. B. I. bears N. 45 1/2° W
 16 links.
