

99.68 I intersect a N & S line 59 lbs South of a rock said to be set by L. C. Roberts. from all other evidence except the rock itself the rock would appear to be too far north by about the distance between the rock and my transit line.

I let the survey rest and returned to town and found there was no record of the rock, and it was not witnessed on the ground although plenty of trees were available.

Mr. Roberts does not remember the rock but says he has no memory of anything definite to set the rock by.

On April the 16<sup>th</sup> I returned and began at the N.W. corner of L 49. I found a rock previously set and the Original B.T. standing and alive. I checked up by the field notes and found the rock to be correct in a link, so I began at the rock and ran a transit line  $S 00^{\circ} 09' E$ . which I prove by joining and turning the angle from the plates, to the E and W. Transit line previously run.

45.05 I entered an East and West line 38 lbs East of a rock previously set in the County road at the N.W. corner of the land preceded to A. H. Fry.

81.29 I intersect Transit line previously run as random South boundary of L 49. - 79.26 Chs. West of the S.E. corner

81.32 I intersect present wire fence at S. bdy of L 49.

At the S.W. corner of the Stage L 51. I found the Original B.T. and a quartz rock in the correct place for the corner.

From this corner I ran a transit line  $N. 00^{\circ} 23' E$ .

80.53 I intersect Transit line previously run from the S.E. corner of the lot L 49.

81.12 To a point 71 lbs west of rock previously set
