Beginning at the line I ran as the division between Lots 2 & 6. I chained on the fence line East between Lots 2 & 3. and find the distance to be 19.00 chains to the river.

As the distance given on the original plat. on the North boundary of Lot 6 is the only one which will check the distances given on the Plat. I run from the N.E. corner of Lot 6. South 1.00 Thence S. $33^{\circ}11'$ E. 29.22 to the Sec corner. as the boundary line between Lots 2 & 6.

Beginning at a point which is quartz boulder, 9x10x12 inches set six inches below the surface of the ground, 13.42 East and 4.22 the North of the corner to Sec. 3, 4, 9 & 10. I ran the center-line of a 20 foot road described as follows.

N. $36^{\circ}58'$ E. 13.56 chains, Thence N. $35^{\circ}59'$ E. 12.91 chains to a dark colored boulder 6x6x12 inches buried, with the top slightly below the surface of the ground.
