Began at the approximate location of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
 bet Secs. 19 and 30 T 22 S R 7 W W.M. find remains
 of trees that correspond with Bearing Trees called
 for in Original field note Check distance West to Small Creek
 and also East to River distances measure as called for
 in original field notes. Set out Stake but do not
 witness trees and establish corner as Beckley's do not
 with the North line of Sec 30 run as a further Check.
 From stake, run $N 89^{\circ} 55' E 17.50$ Chs to the left bank
 of the Yampqua River Thence following the meanders
 as follows $S 14^{\circ} 10' E 4.82$ Chs. Thence $S 45^{\circ} 13' E 14.45$ Chs.
 Thence $S 31^{\circ} 48' E 6.08$ Thence $S 4^{\circ} 49' W 16.82$ Chs.
 Thence $S 26^{\circ} 12' N 15.92$ Chs Thence leaving river and
 following fence line $N 64^{\circ} 31' N 27.51$ Chs. Thence
 $S 30^{\circ} 50' N 11.76$ Chs. Thence $S 39^{\circ} 00' N 5.24$ Chs.
 Thence $S 42^{\circ} 03' W 16.05$ Chs. Thence leaving fence line
 $N 46^{\circ} 32' W 40.73$ Thence $N 89^{\circ} 52' E 17.32$. To the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec Cor bet Secs 30 and 25 which I establish
 from original Bearing Trees which are still standing
 and alive Thence $N 0^{\circ} 48' W 18.86$ Chs. Thence
 $N 89^{\circ} 29' E 37.53$ Thence $N 0^{\circ} 22' W 20.00$ Chs.
 to the place of beginning Containing 267.53 Acres
