Beginning at a point 20.15 chains West from the Cor of Sections 11, 12, 13 & 14 Tp 30 S. R 6 W

Thence N. 0° 17' W. 20.00 chains to a point from which;

A White Oak 14" in dia, marked C S B T bears, N. 30 1/2° E. 412
" Myrtle 12" " " " " " " " " " " S. 31° W. 84

Also record the renewed B T for the quarter Sec Cor bet Secs 11 & 14 Tp 30 S. R 6 W. to wit;

A White Oak 30" in dia, marked 1/2 S. C S bears S. 41° 05' W 232
