

Beginning at the Corner to Secs 19-30-24-25 on the west boundary T 26 S R. 3 W, I search for evidence of Corner and find all Witness Trees alive and standing two of which had been previously chopped out and I chop out two others scribe marks ~~plainly~~ plainly visible on all

I can not make the bearings and distances, called for in original notes, coincide, I fulfill as many calls as possible and set corner which is an oak post also a 1" x 3/4 ft drill stool from which the original trees bear as follows

- An Oak 25" in dia brs N 61° W 134 li.
- " " 30 " " " S 48° E 80 "
- " " 30 " " " N 78° W 239 "
- " " 30 " " " S 54° W 229 "

Thence, on random line, East on S boundary Sec 19

1386 Intersect 1 ft N of a rock set by M B Germond said rock supposed to be on Sec line 6.50 Chs West from the West line of J S Nolan Cl. # 45.

2055 Turn 90° to left and run North on approx Claim line

5.77 Set stake and search for N.W. Cor. of J S Nolan Cl. I find a blazed B. Oak 40" in dia, chop out blazes and find scribe marks. I then find stump of oak 1 ft in diam which I assume is the 4" Oak called for in field notes I search near the stump and find a rock corresponding to rock called for. I make a mound of rock over it and take bearings to trees as follows

- An Oak 18" in dia S 43° E 435 ft
- Old blazed tree S 17° W. 8 ft

small stump previously mentioned is 1 ft South of rock

Then random line intersects 48 links East of Corner. I correct random line by setting over 48 lks to the West for its entire length of 5.77 Chs and set a wagon hub, and oak post for approx S.E. corner to Lot 11. from which

- A B. Oak 20 in dia brs N 16° W 35.5 ft.
