I began the survey at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. between secs. 19 and 20 above tp. and range. I find this cor. in place and note wit. tress all O.K. I run a transit line with mag. bring. of S. 89°-43' W. and at 20.00 chs set in a stake. Then I turn and run a mag. line S. 00°-05' E. by turning left 89°-48' from my initial line at 20.10 " I fall 1 lk. E. of a large madrone stake m'ked. 1/16 S. Mr. Harry Larkins testifies that this cor. was set in by Sur. Theil. Mr. Larkins expressed himself as being satisfied with this random work on this 40 acre tract. I then return to  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. above noted bet. secs. 19 and 20 and run a random needle transit line N. 00°-13' W. and at 40.90 " I fall 10 lks. W. of sec. cor. common to secs 17, 18, 19 and 20 I then correct back on a true line of S. 00°-04 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' E. and set in a point at 20.45 Said pt. is a 3" madrone stake from which  
 A red fir 16" in dia. brs. S. 00°-45' E. 15 lks.  
 A " " 12" " " " N. 12°-00' E. 15 lks.  
 I then run a random line on the mag. bearing of N. 89°-36' E. from this 1/16 cor. and set in points at intervals to mark said line. At 19.93 " I stop random line and set ina large hub. This line was run over a very rough country. Mr. Larkins expressed himself as being satisfied with the work done, and the survey was discontinued for the present time.
