Survey No. Made on Dec. 11-12 1917
 In Town. 28 S. Range 5 W. Sec. 3
 Made for John Cramer ✓
 Purpose of survey was to estab. N. bdy. line of the NW. 1/4 of sec. 3 and the mid pt. there on, and run a random line due S. from said point.

Survey No. Made on Apr. 7th. 1917
 In Town. 27-6 Range 6. Sec. 22
 Made for M.L. Webb and N.W. Crocker
 Purpose of sur. was to set line bet. lots 21 and 22 "Ump. Park Fruit Lands"
R R F. B. 6 = 73.

Began survey at the 1/4 cor. on the North bdy. of sec. 3 of the T. and R. noted above. I reest. this cor. as recorded. I identified the position of the new corner from one of the old original B.Ts.

From above noted cor. I run S.89°-39'W. on the true sec. & town. line and at

2618.5 ft. I reest. sec. cor. as noted in records. The position of said cor. was obtained from old B.Ts. which I find in evidence.

1309.3 ft. I then retrace on line and at a point midway between 1/4 and sec. cor. or from beginning pt. I set in 1/16 sec. cor. which is a 10" X 10" x 18" sandstone. From this 1/16 cor. I run a line true South approx. 1/4 of a mile to the fence between Cramer and Patterson.

Began survey at cor. bet. lots 21 and 22, which I identify. This cor. is set on section line. I run west from this corner to the S.W. Cor. of lot 22, I then return to cor. bet lots 21 & 22 and run east on the section line to the cor. bet. lots 20 and 21. I continue on east to the cor. bet. lots 19 " 20. I then return to the cor. bet. lots 21 & 22 and run due North to the Old Coos Bay wagon road. This last line was the one desired by Messrs Webb and Crocker, who expressed themselves as being satisfied by the survey as performed.
