I intersect the cor. common to sec's. 20,21,28 & 29. I note this cor. is a river basalt stone 6" X 7" X 14" or 16" set around by three smaller stones. I return on my line and at
from my begin. cor. I set in a blue basalt rock 4" X 5" X 14" to mark the sec. line. This stone is witnessed by a B.Oak 15" in dia. which brs. S.03°-00'E. 8.3 ft. I also take a sun reading and compute the true bearing of the line to be. N. 89°-45' W.
