Began survey: the corner common to sections 9,10,15 & 16 T. 28 S., R. 6 W. W.M. I note large stone set for cor. and that it is in position according to Government wit. notes. I run random line south with needle from the above named cor. and set in random points at

- a hub marked pt. No. 1
- a " " " No. 2
- a " " " No. 3 on rt. bank of river.
- a " " " No. 4 " lt. " " " , and offset W. 182.24 lks.
- a " " " No. 5 on offset line

I note that point No 5 falls 123.3 lks. west of cor. common to sections 15. 16, 21 and 22 above Tp. & Rg. From the above random line I compute the true bearing of the section line as S.00°-25'W. I then return to pt. No. 1 and offset west .0207 chs. on to the true line and set in a 3/4" by 30" iron rod. At pt. No. 2, I offset west .07325 chs. and set onto true line/cedar stake. At pt. No. 3, I set in pt. No. 6 which is on random line.

- At point No. 6, I offset west .1465 chs. onto true line and set a 1" by 48" looped eye-bar, from which
  - A W.Oak 15" dia. brs. S. 30 3/4° E. 189.75 lks.
  - A B.Oak 12" " " S. 58 1/2° W. 59.25 lks.

Work was carefully executed and true line was proven to be correctly located. A sun observation could not be obtained. Chainmen and sworn. F.C.Frear and Ralph Haswell

**Survey No.**

Began survey at S.W. Cor. of Mel Ryan's land in above section township and range. This cor. is an iron rod 1 inch in dia. and was set and accepted on a survey made during the year 1916 by myself. From this point/I run
