Survey No. 1 Made on Oct. 7th 1916
In Town. 28 S. Range 5 W. Sec. 11
Made for Oliver Patterson
Purpose of survey was to definitely establish the lines of the ^{GILMORE} Cemetery and re-locate the road leading thereto.

Survey No. 2 Made on 9th. 1916 Oct.
In Town. 28 S. Range 6 W. Sec. 10-15
Made for Poole and Landers
Purpose of survey was for a deed description

Feet

Began survey at N.E. Cor. of Cemetery as located from ties, fences and old description. I reset N.E. Cor. with a iron strap $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" X 30". Thence from this cor. I run

264.0 South and set in the S.E. Cor. with a 4" oak stake, thence

165.0 West and set in the S.W. Cor. with a 4 " oak stake, thence

264.0 North and set in the N.W. Cor with S. Stone 6" X 8" X 29" marked with a X and C.S.

165.0 East to place of beginning and iron strap. The area of Cemetery is one acre.

From a pt. set on the west bdy. of the cemetery $8\frac{1}{2}$ ft. S. of N.W. cor I run the Cen. line of a road $16\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in width as follows;- S. $79^{\circ}-15'$ W. 184.8 ft., S. $68^{\circ}-45'$ W. 254.0 ft. to the Co. road. The cemetery survey was tied to the N.E. cor. of Cl. No. 41 as follows.-

The work was carefully performed. The chaining was by the Surveyor and Mr. Patterson. The N.E. Cor of the Cl. No. 41 was reest. as noted in records.

N, $87^{\circ}-19'$ W.

301.0 to a post. thence

N. $01^{\circ}-38'$ W.

781.9 to place of beginning
