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Began the survey at the S.E. Cor. of the tract, which was located by fence lines and testimony of parties owning the property. This point is called sta. 1 and is $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 18" gal. iron pipe. Thence I run around the parcel of land as follows.-

N. 00°-21' E. 481.25 ft. set in $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 18" iron pipe.

N. 89°-14' E. 1307.28 ft. to N. W. Cor.

S. 01°-01' E. 482.00 ft. to N.E. Cor.

S. 89°-16' W. 1318.68 ft. to place of beginning. This tract of land was sub-divided into lots 1-2-3-4. The descriptions of these lots were written up for Mr. Pargeter a copy of which is in file Envelope No. ... Lots 3-4 of this tract was further sub-divided into 5 smaller lots and the corner stakes set. No record of these smaller lots will be made except the sketch shown in the field book. No attempt was made to run out the tie lines of these descriptions as Mr. Pargeter requested that no such a survey be made. The work was well done. The chaining was by M.B. Germond and F.C. Frear. A sun bearing of the lines were obtained.

Began this survey at the big stone, that marks the N.E. Cor. of D.L.C. No. 45 in sec. 20 above tp and range. Thence I run around the parcel of land as follows using the needle as no true bearing could be obtained.

N. 89°-53' W. 842.0 ft.

N. 06°-05' W. 1182.0 ft. to a sand stone monment 8" x 9" x 16" then along Co. Road

S. 63°-12' E. 982.7 "

S. 64°-19' E. 98.6 "

S. 00°-08' E. 692.1 " to the place of beginning. The work was for the sole purpose of obtaining a deed description and no legal boundaries were established. The chaining was of about 2nd. class.
