Began the survey at a pt on the side of the new County road said pt is a 1 x 18 G I P and bears 100°-27', 15 47 chs from the rock that marks the N Cor of Cl 57 I call this pt A and run around the small piece of land as follows -

N 81°-08' E 5 275 chs
 N 61°-54' E 1 898
 N 55°-29' E 1 565 to a 1 x 18 G I P
 N 89°-30' 8 20 x 10 I bolt and to pt B
 S 00°-27' E 2 666 and to place of beginning this survey was made for Joe Large
 I then return to pt B and run N 00°-27' 1
 7 77 to the N E Cor of Cl No 56 and a rock I call this pt C and continue my line on the same bearing of N 00°-27' but begin new chaining at pt C and at
 26 59 from pt C I set in a 4 x 5 x 36 cedar stake and call it pt D From pt D I run N 89°-33' E
 3 19 to the cor common to secs 14 15 22 23 I mark sec cor with a 1 1/2 x 30 G I P 9 45 chs
 I then return to pt D and run S 89°-33' and set a 4 cedar stake at the intersect of my line with an old fence line that is presumed to be the east line of claim No 50/ I call cedar stake pt E
 I then from the line C - D and line D - E write up a deed description and compute the area of the tract

Henry and Large expressed themselves as being satisfied with the work and the survey as discontinued at this point
