I began the survey at the corner of secs 13 14 23 24 wh cor I identify from the old bearing trees I set in a 1/2 x 2' x 16 iron bar at this cor and call the same pt "A" From pt A I run around the piece of land as follows -

- S 00 -30'W 40 00 chs to a 2 x 48" G I P on rt bank of S Umpqua River
- S 00 -30 W 4 52 to center of stream
- N 34°-10'E 11 65 up
- N 52°-26'E 7 01 "
- N 61°-47'E 16 51 " "
- N 49°-03'W 5 00 to a plowshare on rt bank of stream
- N 49 -03 / 29 78 " to the place of beginning Said tract of land contains 52 23 acres of land more or less

After the above work was completed the work of making a road survey thro the Hanks, Rose and willis places was taken up This road survey was completed and a record of the work is found in the Records of Deeds in the County Clerks' office

The entire work was carefully executed and closed up good A new Gurley transit was used on the work All lines were run from sun bearings
