The lines ran by F.C.Frear were all transit Sun lines and the most of the work closed up accurately and the chaining was good. However the other surveys or at least part of them were only needle work and some of them did not close up.

The <sup>surveys</sup> *A* ran by Frear are all marked on at least two of the lines by iron pipes or rocks thus enabling another Surveyor to re-trace the surveys made by him.

Owing to the fact that some of the work was tied onto the work of other surveys it was impossible to make a clear record of the work.
