 by traverse line to avoid brush, for traverse line notes see
 F.B. No 18.

2647.8 I Intersected $\frac{1}{4}$ cor established from the remains of old BT which
 I found down but which checked so closely for distance and
 direction that I assumed it to be the tree called for in field
 notes .

Thence S 89°59' W

1043.4 ft To Sw. Cor Cl 44 which I established from the original B.T.

2651.8 To Cor .3 trees standing, set an iron pipe.

Thence N 0°08'E

2662.7 To $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. Established from stump of cedar bearing tree, and
 remains of old stake

Thence N0°05'E

2659.6 Sec cor Stake

From cor to Secs 23-24 & 25-26 I ran a traverse West and
 found the remains of the bearing trees for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec cor bet Secs.
 23 & 26 Renewed the corner as recorded in Book of Govt Corners
 and placed points in the interior of section as shown on plat

NOTE

Traverse lines were run by transit angles, in all cases where
 brush and large trees could be avoided..and distance and direction
 between corners were computed by latitudes and departures
 A check on nearly all of the work was obtained by closing on
 lines previously run. directions were checked frequently by
 solar observations recorded in the back of FB No 18.
