In addition to the chainmen and markers above mentioned I had assisting me Walter Coats as axeman, and J. Coats representing himself and J. O. Coats representing Mrs. Anna Weland, were present during the greater part of the time during which said survey was made.

That all calculations made in said survey were made by latitude and departure, and the course of all lines traced or established is as found by observation of the sun and the magnetic variation of the needle, and all angles were read from the vernier; that in all matters in connection with said survey I followed strictly the provisions of Chapter XXIII, Oregon Laws.

That I have heretofore filed a plat showing the lines and corners established by said survey and a brief and succinct narrative of the survey as it was actually done on the ground, which said plat and narrative are filed in Volume 10.3 Survey Records at pages thereof.
