An iron pipe 1 1/4"x40" from which Fir 36" in dia S74°30' 21.3 ft.
 Fir 12 in. in dia S47°E 1.0 ft.

I set an iron pipe at the intersection of the North boundary of Sec 28 and the East and West boundaries of D.L.C. 45

This survey was executed by running random traverse lines, as close to the true lines as could be estimated, and all courses measured with the transit plates, and the angles were carefully measured and doubled. The distances were chained with a 300 ft. tape along the slopes and the horizontal measurements obtained by computation. The position of all points were determined by Latitudes and Departures and the directions and lengths of all established lines were computed likewise.

All bearings shown above are Magnetic and should be corrected 0°12' to the Left to compare with True Solar directions.

All lines were very distinctly blazed, A.E. Rice and M.B. Hawkins assisted me during the entire survey
