I began the survey at one of the original corners of the N. Curry plat and established the division lines on the boundaries of the lots, and ran the division lines across the lots. I then calculated the acreage and made a description for each tract.

Field notes and map are in Vault no. 2 Eng. 31

I ran around a portion of Lot 6 of Sec. 27, beginning at a stone said to be the S.W. Corner of the lot, and calculated the acreage to be 4.15 acres. this tract was to be retained by Williams. I then ran around another portion of ^{Nichols' land} Lot 6, commencing at a stone 436 feet east of the S.W. Cor. of Lot 6, calculated the acreage to be 2.6 acres and made a description. This tract to be traded to Williams by Nichols. I then ran around another and remaining portion of Lot 6 lying above the county, road beginning at the 1/4 corner between 22 and 27, This land to be traded to Williams by Nichols. I calculated this tract to contain 2.46 acres. Lot. 5 containing 2.44 acres to be traded to Williams by Nichols
 I then laid off a strip of land 75.9 feet wide on the east side of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 22, containing 2.3 acres which to be traded to Williams by Nichols, which would make the land exchanged equal.
