Survey No. 270 Made on Aug. 16, 1924 In Town. 22 S Range 6 # Sec. 9-16 Made for Sumner Snell --Snell Estate Purpose of Description of property lying between the old county road and the right of way of the Oregon Western R.R. not deeded by Edward and Laura Snell Division of property deeded to Charles and Sumner Snell. 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I began the survey at the exterior "S" corner of the Joseph Putman D.L.C. No. 38 which was an old stake properly marked on sides and satisfying the requirement of one B.T. Mr Putman said the stake was set by a Surveyor from old B.T.'s., thence North along the West line of said claim 594.6 ft., to a point in the center of the old Drain Elkton road, thence following the old road N 52° 41' W 169.9 ft., N 44° 48' W 1156.1 ft. to a point in the present county road, thence following present road which is approximately in the same place as the old road, N 44° 48' W 191 ft., N 57° 08' W 199 ft., N 58° 28' W 251.2 ft., N 76° 29' W 261.5 ft., N 81° 39' W 190.5 ft., S 89° 19' W 271.0 ft., S 81° 48' W 249.8 ft., to a point in the road and on the line between Sections 8 and 9 T 22 S R 6 W., thence I ran South 58 ft., to the corner common to section 8-9-16-17 and from there a random line to the approximate center line of the right of way of the Oregon Western R.R. I was unable to find any of the center line hubs upon the right of way but a number of grade stakes were still in evidence but all stationing obliterated. I continued the line easterly along the approximate center of the right of way as determined by the limits of the clearing, as follows,  
 S 85° 23' E 543.1 ft., S 61° 13' E 84.2 ft., S 73° 43' E 232.2 ft., S 73° 27' E 98.6 ft., S 70° 16' E 167.3 ft., S 68° 28' E 814.4 ft., and from this point I ran a random line across Elk creek to an old hub near the North bank of the creek which appeared to be in the center of the right of way and a point for the end of a bridge across the creek, and between these points I calculated the bearing and distance to be S 62° 31' E 180.6 ft., thence following the right of way, S 67° 48' E 521.7 ft., to a point on the West line of the Joseph Putman D.L.C. and 311.2 feet North of the beginning corner.

I then returned to the exterior "L" corner of D.L.C.#38 and ran a line N 89° 32' E 538.5 ft. and set a temporary point from which the Interior "L" corner of Claim #38 bears N 88° W 7. ft., I was unable to occupy the corner as it was between several trees. I then ran South 745.8 ft to a point on the West line of said claim which intersects the  $\frac{1}{2}$  line thru center of section 16. I obtained this distance from the government field notes. Mr. Sumner Snell and Mr. Putman, the interested landholders expressed themselves as satisfied with the position of the corner. I set a stake and Mr. Putman agreed to to place an iron pin there. I then ran West and at 2996.2 ft., set an 4" x 4" x 36" stake ~~from~~ which is approximate the  $\frac{1}{2}$  corner between sections 16 and 17.
