Report on Abs. No. 13 coverin the follwoing described property

All of lots numbered one in Block Numbered twenty-seven and lot numbered three i in block numbered twenty-eight in the town of Winchester, Douglas county, Ore.

All that parcel of land fifty feet by one hundred feet, comprising one half of the Northeast half of Lot numbered four of Block numbered twenty-eight and one-half of the Northeast half of Lot numbered seven in block numbered twenty-eight in the Town of Winchester in Douglas county, Oregon.

The town of Winchester eas established as shown on the attached map, from the initial point, which was reset from evidences of block corner found on the ground.

A line was run from the East side of Bridge street 1360 feet along the North sides of Blocks 25-26-27, establishing the Northwest corner of block 27, and thence 50 feet, establishing the East line of Block No. 28. These lines are shown in Orange on the attached map.

A residence is located on Lot. 3, of Block 28 and until about a year ago was enclosed by a fence. This fence has been removed but the evidence of its location is still plain. According to our location of lot 3 this fence would fall bout 15 feet East of the lot line.

Residents of Winchester say the fence has been there a long time but cannot give a definite date, and we were unable to determine wether it was built previous to the platting of the town of Winchester or later. The black lines upon the map show the location of the parcels under examination as established by the fence.

The East one-half of lots 6 and 7 of Block 28 are not under fence or in any use by the COPC<sup>0</sup>. From the evidence on the ground it would be impossible determine what parcels the dead in question referred to.
