The survey was begun at the 1/4 corner between Sec. 23-22 ~~was~~ at which point a Laurel Marked C.S. 1/4 S 23 B.T. bears S 41 E 221 feet, and a traverse run to the beginning point of the road, and along the center line of the road, and a deed description prepared.

Description furnished Mr. Pierce

Beginning at a point from which the 1/4 corner common to sections 22-23 Township 26 South, Range 7 West, Willamette meridian, Douglas county, Oregon, bears S 89° 22' E 858.7 feet distant, thence following on the center line of a sixteen (16) foot road as follows,

- N 12° 30' E 194.6 feet
- N 05° 53' W 200.6 feet
- N 81° 01' W 183.1 feet
- N 29° 13' E 184.6 feet
- N 47° 19' E 132.0 feet
- N 65° 35' E 138.3 feet to the county road.

Mr. Pierce petitioned for a gateway road from his place to the County Road over a different route than the one above described. Notes of this view are in Env. 50 vault 8. This route was not opened.
