N 65°E ..77 find oak properly marked

These two trees check and at S 77°E 1.00 find B.T. properly marked but neither bearing or distance checks being given as S 47°W 38 lks. Practically South 56 lks. find old charred stump but bearing does not check. I set the corner by the first two P.T.s and abandon last two as they will not check out.

Set a 6 x 6 x 24 white oak stake scribed S 21-22-27-28 C.S. and marked

From corner to 21-22-27-28 as re-established, I ran North on random line

20.00 Set temporary point move 14 lks. South and 37 lks. west 1/16 cor.

40.00 Set temporary point " 28 " " " 74.5 lks. west.

At 39.72 end on line between cor. to Sec. 21-22-27-28 and cor to frac. Sec. 21 and 22, I re-establish 1/4 corner, A stone 4 x 4 x 20 marked 1/4

A Red fir bears N 24°30'E 8 lks, I scribed this 1/4 S 22 C.S.

This being close to the B.T. given for the 1/4 corner but no marks visible

A laurel stump bears E W 16 lks. but no marks visible

A Laurel 15" Bears N 45°W 30 lks. 1/4 S 21 C.S.

42.10 Intersected corner 78 lks. East of Established corner below
