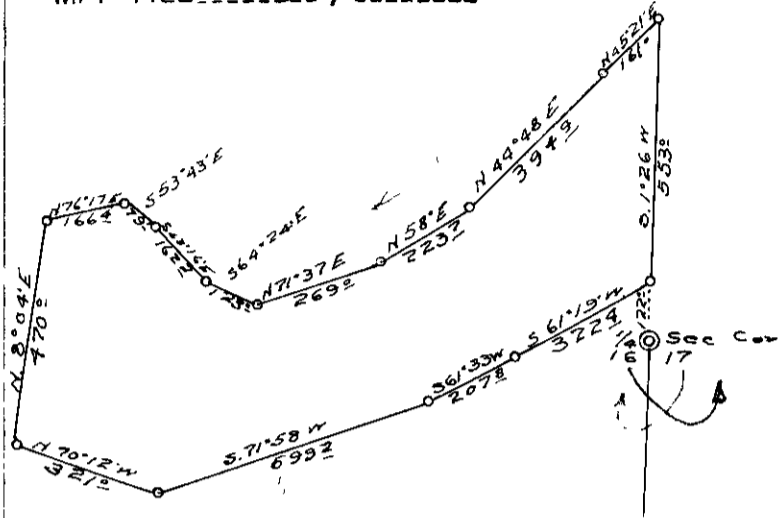

On Aug 11th, 1936, I made a survey for Mr S.I. Thackery of Myrtle Ck to determine the west line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec 26 Twp 28S.R.4W; W.M.
 I first set up at an iron pipe set by H.L. Eppstein, County Surveyor for the section corner common to sections 22, 23, 26 and 27 and checked all bearing trees for distance and bearing as he recorded them, referring to Page 23 of this same record book, I used the same magnetic bearing that Mr Eppstein used of 22°-02'E in checking in these trees and also for the rest of this work; after finding that all the trees checked for distance and bearing using the magnetic declination of 22°-02'E, I set on a course of 30°-47'E, as given in Mr Eppsteins notes for the line between secs. 26 and 27 as shown on page 23 of this book, I ran out the West line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ said section 26, the distance measured to determine the S.W. corner of this NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ being 1/4th of the 2524.5 ft. given by Mr Eppstein on page 23 of this record book (No. 4) as the distance between the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. sec. 26, or the distance measured being 631.12 ft. where a stake was driven by Mr Cox for the SW corner of this NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and he also set a stake at the fence on the North and South sides of the county road on the West line of this NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$.
