Purpose of	Establishing lines and corners E. Williamson D.L.C. No 48.

This survey was commenced at the SW corner of the E. Williamson D.L.C. No 48, which is a sandstone 6"x12"x12" above the ground and located at an angle in the County Road between Sutherlin and Elkton.

A traverse was run around the boundaries of the E. Williamson D. L. C. No. 48 tying in all corners which could be located and definitely identified. The S.E. and the N.E. corners had been completely destroyed or obliterated. The N.W. corner of the claim is an oak post set, as described in the records of the County Surveyor, ~~xx~~ by Surveyor Briggs in 1892. The bearing tree had fallen down and the butt had burned out. Its location is as recorded.

The interior angle corner on the west boundary of the claim is located at an old corner fence post which checks as to location from two bearing trees as noted by Surveyor Briggs and recorded in the Office of the County Surveyor. The trees had been cut, but scribe marks were plainly visible when chopped out.

The exterior angle corner on the west boundary of DLC No 48. had been destroyed. It was re-located by using the tie from the N.E. Corner of the Jos. Cline DLC. No.49 which is a sandstone 3"x12"x12" above ground as recorded in the original ~~xxxx~~ field notes. The distance between these two corners is North 82 lks. ~~xxx~~ The corner of DLC. 48 is in the corner of the F. A. Bemis prune orchard.

In order to determine the location of the SE corner of DLC No 48 the Traverse of the south boundary was continued east to the NW corner of lot 5 block 8 Plat M Sutherlin Land and Water Co. which is on the North boundary of D.L.C No 59 and a continuation of the south boundary of DLC 48. The SE corner was set on this line and by proportional distances between the SW corner of DLC 48 and the NE cor of DLC 59. The NE corner of the DLC 48 was determined by ties given in the Deed Description of the property now owned by C.A.Goff, which is a part of the J.H. Medley DLC No 46. This deed reads in part; " -- Thence leaving the stream S 81°W 11.35 chs. to the west boundary of the J. H. Medley donation land claim and an oak post from which a white oak 24" dia. mkd. BT bears N 41½°E 3.59 chs., Thence North along the west boundary of the J.H.Medley DLC 54.10 chs. to the NW corner of said claim --". The West boundary of the J.H.Medley DLC No 46 coincides with the East boundary of the Williamson DLC No 48. The SW corner of the Medley Dlc No 46 was determined from the tie given in deed to J.M Leeper which reads in part --"Beginning at a point 88 lks North of the SW corner of the J. H. Medley DLC in T 25S R 6 W Wm., Running thence North 3.54 chs. to a post on the south side of the county road from which a black oak marked BT bears N 62°E 11 lks"----. From these two points on the boundary of the Medley DLC NO 46 the location of the NE corner of DLC no 48 and the SW cor of DLC 46 were determined. The attached map of this survey is a part of this record and shows bearings and distances and a description of all corners.
