Survey was commenced July 23, 1945 at Corner No. 1 of H. E. S. No. 178 in Section 21, T. 26 S., R. 2 E., W.M.

I ran a traverse from Corner No. 1 to Corner No. w using a magnito variation of 20° East. I then corrected the assumed bearing to agree with the original bearing of the line Cor. 1-2 and proceeded with the survey running a traverse on line 2-3 and 3-4.

I then computed a point on the line 3-4 to correspond with the deed description recorded in Vol. 108, Page 260 of the deed records of Douglas County and ran north to intersect the line 7-1 of the original H. E. S. No. 178.

I then ran a traverse along the line 7-1 and set the point on this line to agree with the deed description noted above and corrected the west line to fit the deed description.

A tie was made to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner between sections 20 & 21 and the bearing computed to the S W Corner of the deed description. The map attached hereto shows the result of this work.

All angles were turned in deflection and doubled to insure accuracy. Chaining was with a 300 ft. Chicago Steel tape slope angles being read and horizontal distances computed where necessary.
