Because of being unable to compute the distance between the section corners 22-23-26-27 and 23-24-25-26 from the plat of Umpqua Park the distances along the section line to establish the southeast corner of the west 20 acres of lot 14 was taken as that shown on the plat and the proportional part of lot 14 taken by computing the following:

20 : 33.5 :: x : 460. which being solved gave a value of 274.6 ft. so the corner of this tract was established at a distance of 278 plus 315 plus 315 plus 274.6 ft or 1182.6 ft. east from the section corner and a pipe was driven in the ground at this point. A line was then run north to the Old Coos Bay Wagon Road where another pipe was driven.

All traverses were run by turning angles in deflection and doubling them for check. All measurements were made from the transit on the slope with the vertical angle being read by the transit. Angles were turned from a bearing of a line of the traverse as determined from a solar observation for meridian. A Buff & Buff transit was used for measuring angles and a 300 ft. steel tape for measuring distance. All equipment was in good adjustment and repair and the work carefully done.

All field notes and computation sheets are filed in folder 47 drawer 38 and a map attached hereto and forming a part of this record. The tracing is filed in drawer 55
