A traverse was run from a fence corner on a property line, as run by A. Boyer, County Surveyor, November 1944, Southeasterly along a fence line on a spur to the river. A line was run to the west property line of the Oliver Ranch where a tie was made to the survey made by Boyer for a Deed from Mr. Oliver to C. W. Miller.

After checking in the office it was discovered that this survey combined with that by Boyer would not close. Mr. Oliver did not want to spend more money for surveying.

The section corner 9-10-15-16, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner 9-16 and the meander corner 15-16, had been collocated.

The attached map illustrates conditions found and is made a part of this record.
