Following discrepancies are noted:

The east-west tie is erroneous in the original description by about 276'.

This survey was dependant upon the South boundary of the Kennedy property and the North property line of Tom Parkinson and the highway line and the property was taken in just back, East from the highway to the existing fence line; the age of which fence I would judge to be at least fifteen years of age.
