The survey was started at an iron bolt monumenting the Northeast corner of Block 11, East Drain, said monument also being on the Easterly boundary of the W. N. Goodell DLC #40, in T 22 S, R 5 W, WM. A 1 1/4 inch iron pipe, the Northeast corner of Block 3, East Drain, also on the Easterly boundary of said DLC was found and from these monuments the Westerly boundary of the Mattoon property was established.

Four lots were laid off, and monumented with iron pipes at the corners in accordance with instructions.

These lots were tied to the corner of Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T 22 S, R 5 W, WM., a 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap marked County Surveyor's Office S 8-9-16-17.

The results of the survey are shown on the attached map, which is a part of this record.

All angles were turned and doubled on a Lietz transit with plates reading to 30 seconds of arc, in good adjustment and repair. All chaining was done by experienced chainmen, using a 300 ft. Chicago Steel tape in excellent condition. Measurements were made on the slope and reduced to the horizontal.
