The survey was started and completed on April 29, 1968, with the following crew:

The survey was made as a legal survey at the request of Henry L. Handy to establish the south boundary of Lots 1, 2 and 3, "Kruse Tracts" in Section 1, Township 27 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

Legal notices were sent to the following by registered mail with return receipts requested:

A Buff & Buff Transit and 300 foot tape were used. All angles were doubled. A closed traverse connecting the south boundary and north boundary of Lots 1 and 2 was run with an error of closure of one foot in seven thousand feet.

All monuments were found, effecting this survey, to be reasonably close to record as shown on "Kruse Tracts", except the monument on the south boundary of Lot 1 that had been set on the bank of Elgarose Creek. Record distance from the southeast corner of Lot 1 would place this monument, at this time, in Elgarose Creek. We set a 3/4" iron rod on the existing bank of the creek and on the south boundary of Lot 1.

The attached map is a part of this record and shows the results of this survey. All field notes are filed in County Surveyor's File No. 54/66.
