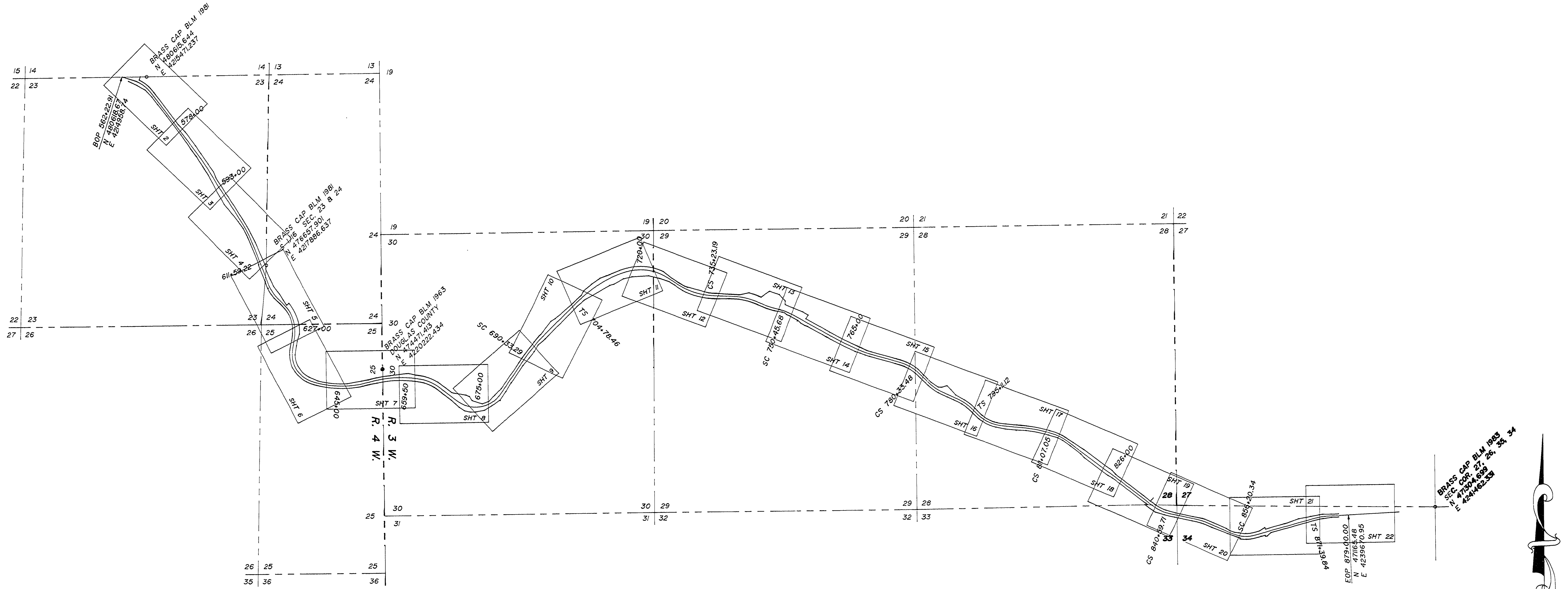

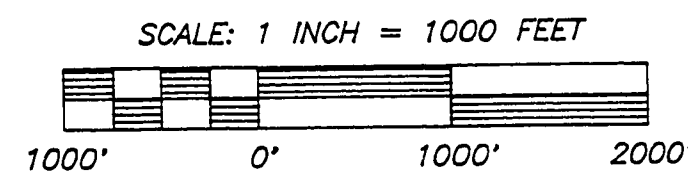

NARRATIVE:
 The purpose of this survey was to locate and reference existing monuments and to monument the newly acquired Right-of-Way as shown on U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration Right-Of-Way map entitled Canyonville-Trail Highway (Oregon Forest Highway Project PFH 16-1[3] dated July, 1995.

The centerline of the Canyonville-Trail Highway was determined from control set by Federal Highway Administration. The centerline was then held and offsets calculated. Monuments were then set at record offsets or as noted.
