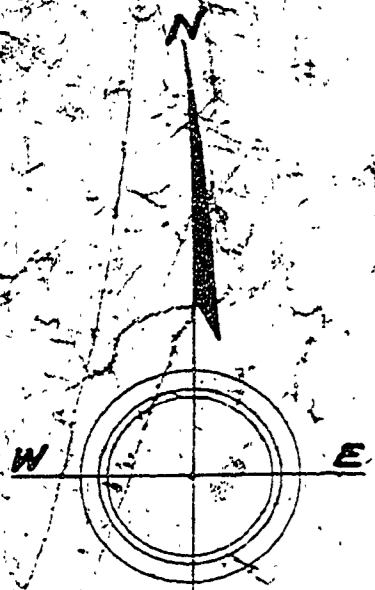


TRACT I. PLAT I.

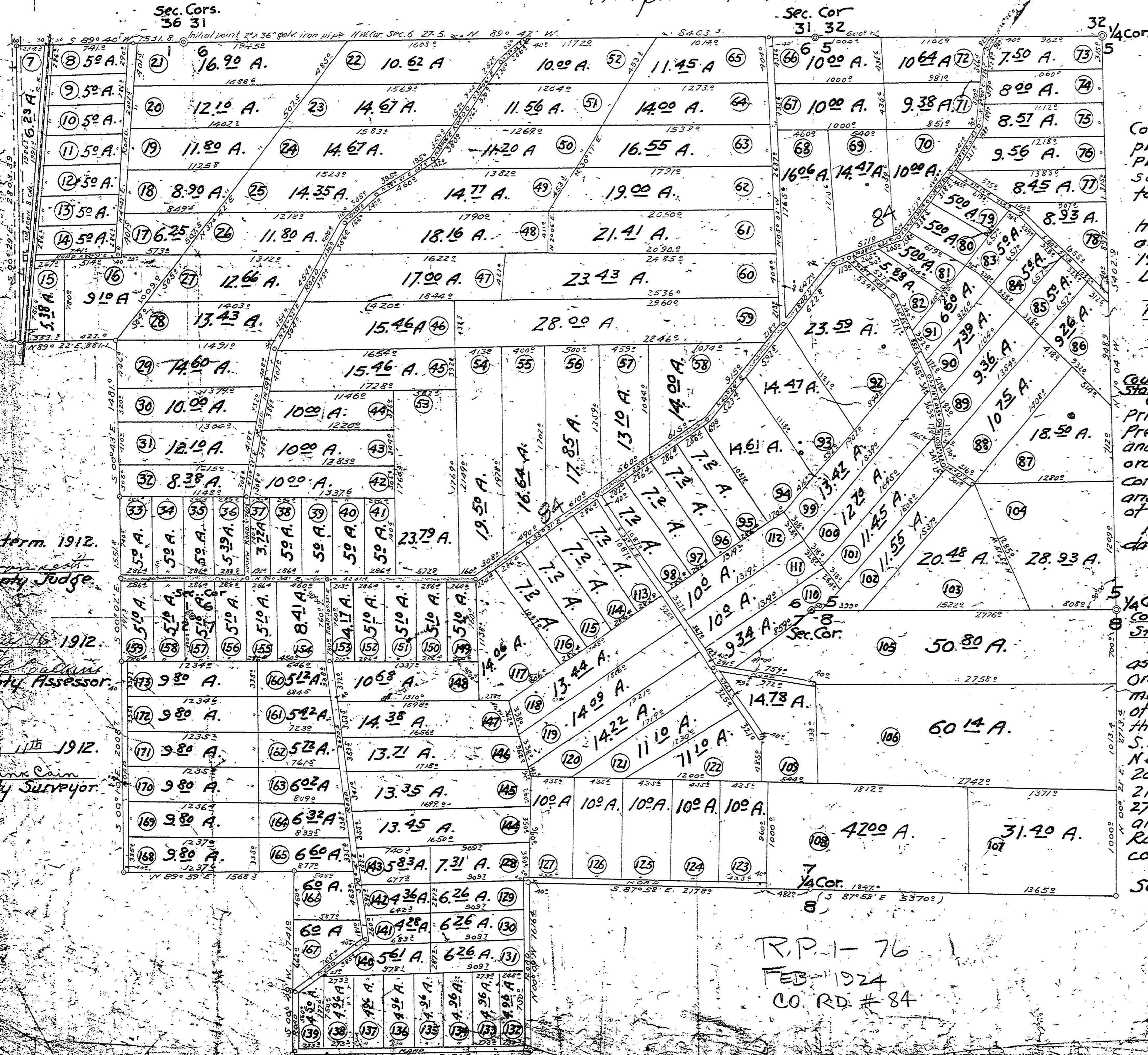
