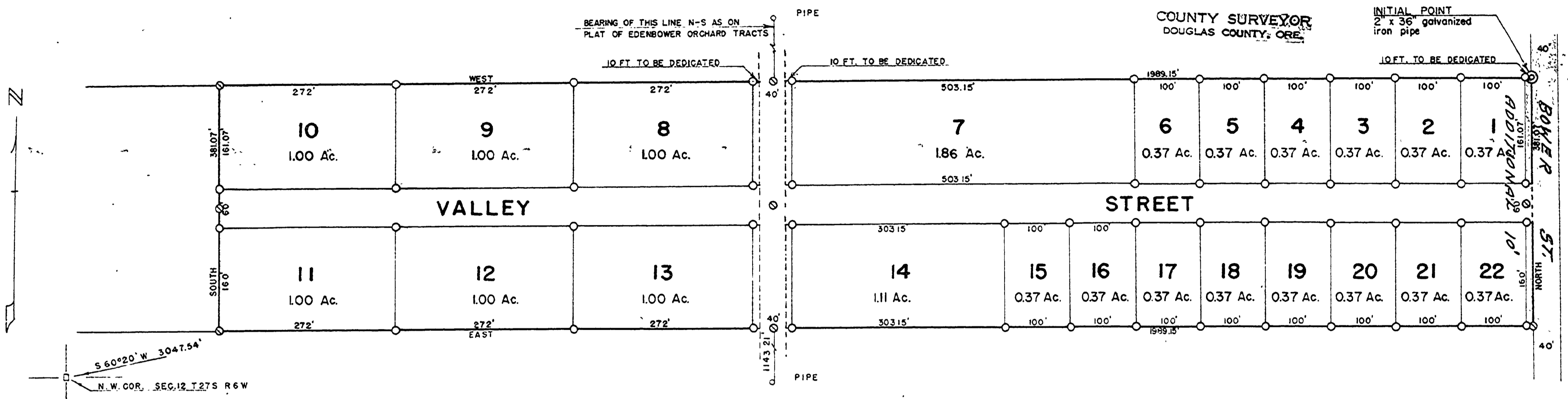

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, PERCY C. ARMSTRONG, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:
Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, set 6" below the surface of the ground at the N.E. corner of LOT 19 of EDENBOWER ORCHARD TRACTS and from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 12, T27S, R 6W, W.M. in Douglas County, Oregon bears S 60° 20' W 3047.54 ft., thence West 1989.15 ft along the North boundary of Lots 19 and 20 of said Edensbower Orchard Tracts to a 1" x 30" iron pipe, thence South 381.07 ft to a 1" x 30" iron pipe at the South boundary of said Lot 20, thence East 1989.15 ft along the South boundary of Lots 20 and 19 to a 1" x 30" iron pipe in the SE corner of said Lot 19, thence North along the East boundary of said Lot 19, 381.07 ft to the place of beginning, containing 17.40 acres, more or less.
