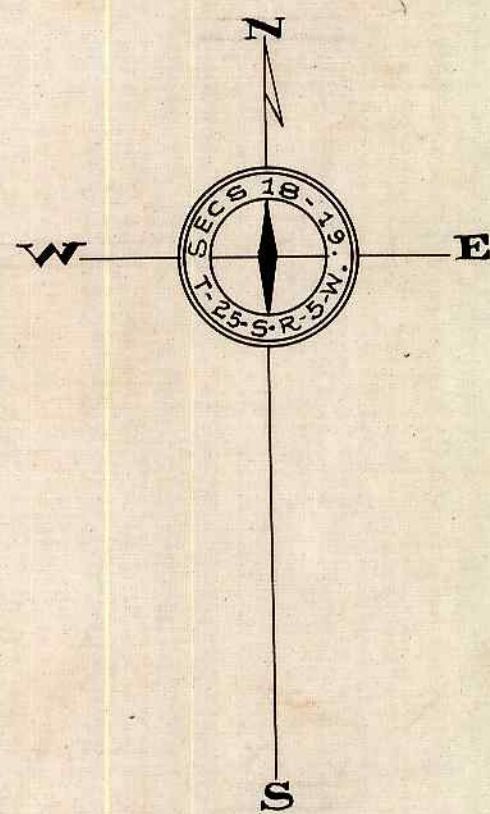
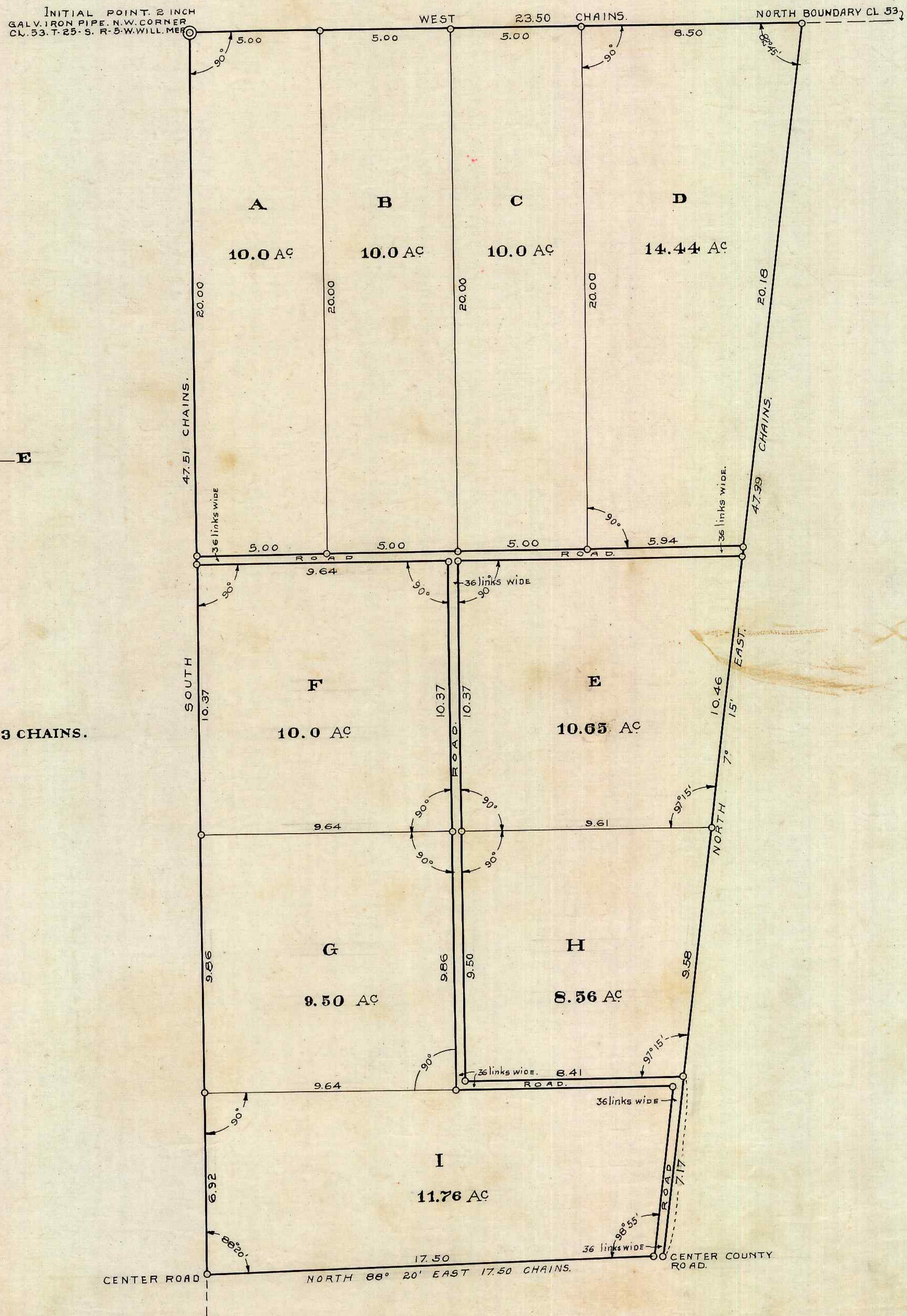


VALLEYVIEW.
