I, Sidney Strong, being duly Sworn, depose and say, that I am the Chief Engineer of The Sutherlin Land & Water Company, a corporation duly incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Oregon; that I have had surveyed under my direction the tract of land shown on the above Plat and known as Plat "K" of the Sutherlin Land & Water Company; that the survey and plat are correct and that the corners and lots have been marked with proper monuments as directed by law.

I have had set an Initial Point a 2 by 36 in. galvanized iron pipe at the N.W. Cor. Lot 1, Blk. 1, Plat "K" from which a stone, the N.W. Cor. of Cl. 44, Twp. 25 S., R. 5 W., Willamette Meridian, Douglas Co. State of Oregon bears S. 25° 1' E. 307.2 Ft.; thence S. 0° 43' E. 7925.0 Ft. to a stone monument the S.W. Cor. Plat "K" thence N. 89° 36' E. 586.0 Ft. to a stone monument; thence N. 0° 36' W. 1296.4 Ft. to a stone monument; thence S. 89° 35' E. 1313.5 Ft. to a stone monument, the one fourth Cor. of Secs. 24, 19, Twp. 25 S. R. 5 W. & W. thence N. 89° 36' E. to a 3 in. White Oak tree; thence N. 89° 35' W. 228.5 Ft. to a stone monument; thence N. 0° 45' W. 423.2 Ft. to a stone monument the S.W. Cor. Cl. 44, Twp. 25 S., R. 5 W. thence N. 89° 31' E. 389.1 Ft. to a stone monument from which a stone monument the N.E. Cor. of Cl. 50, Twp. 25 S., R. 4 W. bears S. 89° 31' W. 541.9 Ft.; thence N. 39° 43.8 Ft. to a 2 in. by 36 in. Pipe, the N.E. Cor. Plat "K" from which a 3 in. Oak Post the S.W. Cor. Cl. 51, Twp. 25 S., R. 4 W. bears S. 89° 45' W. 4744.3 Ft. to the N.W. Cor. Plat "K" point of beginning.
