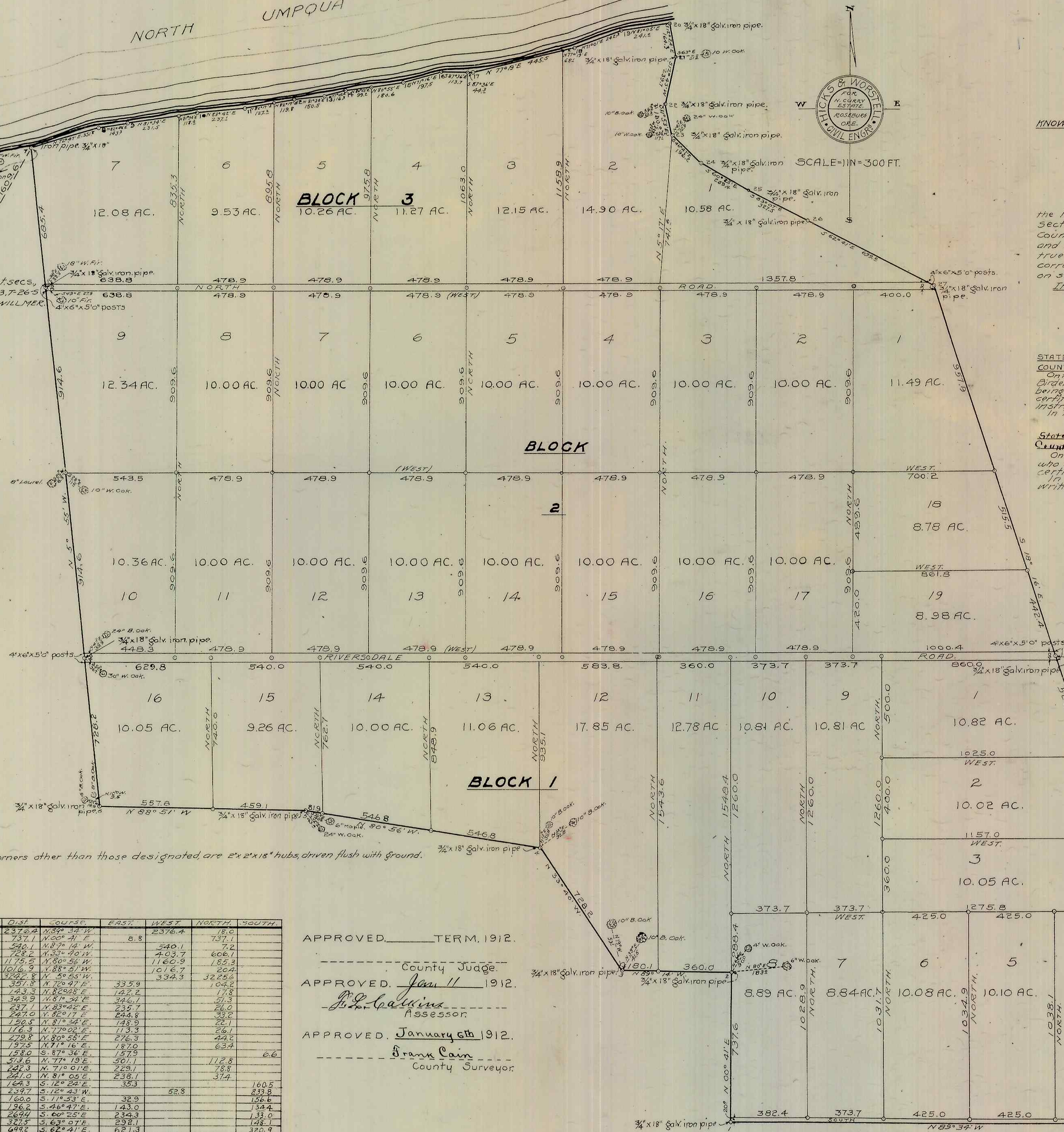


PLAT A. RIVERSDALE

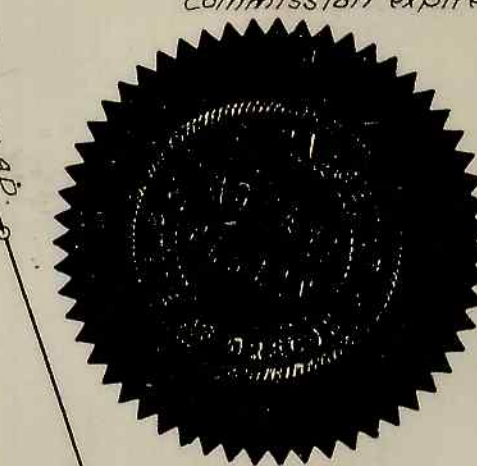
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

 We, L. G. Hicks and R. Worstell, being first duly sworn, depose and say that we are Civil Engineers and Surveyors; that we have surveyed the tract of land shown on the above plat and known as PLAT A, RIVERSDALE; that the survey and plat are correct and that the corners and lots have been marked with proper monuments as directed by Law.
 We have set an Initial Point, a 2" by 3" galvanized iron pipe, from which the 1/4 corner between Sec. 34 in Twp-26-S, and Sec. 3 in Twp-27-S, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas Co., Oregon, bears N 60° 55' E 146.4 feet.
