I, E.L. Robinson, being duly sworn, upon oath say that I am a Civil Engineer and Surveyor by occupation.

That I have prepared the foregoing plat and petition for vacation of plat at the request of W.P. Reed and Reedsport Company and that said plat is described as follows, to-wit:

Tract 1.- All of that part of the Plat of Railroad Addition to Reedsport, Douglas County, Oregon, bounded by a line beginning at the N.W. Corner of Block 14 and running thence Southerly to the S.W. Corner of Block 27; thence along the Northerly side of F Ave. to the center of 6th St.; thence Southerly along the center line of 6th St. to the Northerly side of G St.; thence along the Northerly side of G St. to the center of 8th Ave.; thence along the Northerly side of 8th Ave. to the Southerly side of W. Railroad Ave.; thence along the Southerly side of W. Railroad Ave. to the boundary of the Plat at the Limpqua River; thence Northerly along the boundary of the Plat to the place of beginning.

Tract 2.- All of Block 45: lots 8 to 13, and the alley frontage, Block 46: East Railroad Ave. fronting Block 45 and 14th St. from the N. Side of G St. to the Northerly side of East Railroad Ave.

Tract 3.- All of Blocks 49, 50 and 77, the Street between Blocks 49 and 50, and the Street between 49 and 50 and Block 77: the Alley in Block 77.
