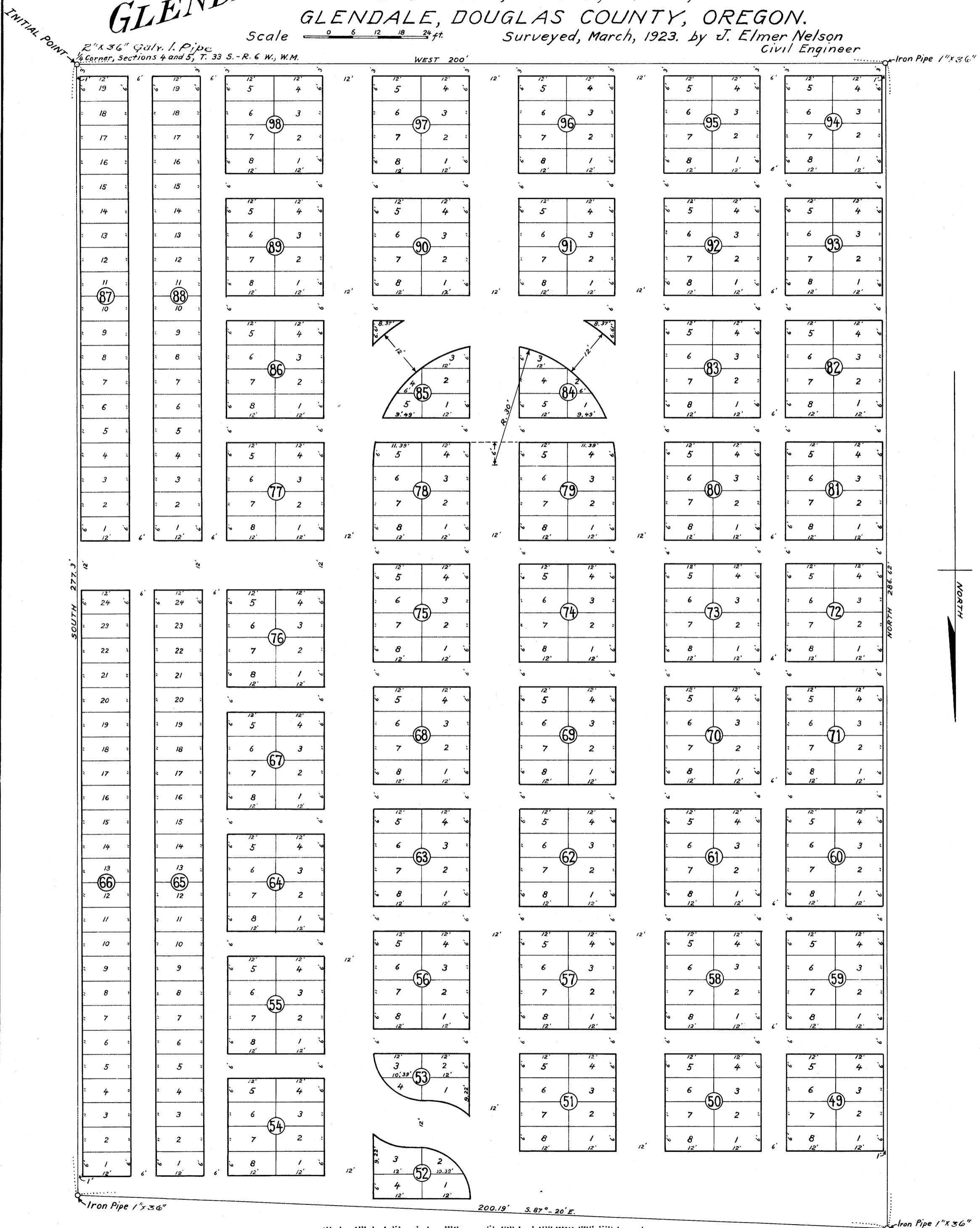


FIRST ADDITION To the GLENDALE A.F. & A.M. CEMETERY AZALEA LODGE No 119

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, AZALEA LODGE No.119 A. F. & A. M. hereinafter described real property, situated in Section 5 Township 33 south Range 6 west, willamette Meridian, Glendale, Douglas County, Oregon. Declare the annexed map or plat to be true and correct. The property platted is more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between sections 4 and 5, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W.M. running thence west along the quarter section line a distance of 200 feet to a iron pipe thence north a distance of 286.62' to a iron pipe said pipe being the southwest corner of the Masonic Cemetery of Glendale, Douglas County, Oregon; thence South $87^{\circ}-20'$ East along the south boundary of said Cemetery a distance of 200.19' to a iron pipe in line between sections 4 and 5, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W.M. thence south along the section line a distance of 277.3' to the place of beginning. The lots and roadways or avenues are of the dimension's shown on the said plat. And we hereby dedicate to the Public forever, as roadways, all portions of said land shown as roadways or avenues by said plat.
