

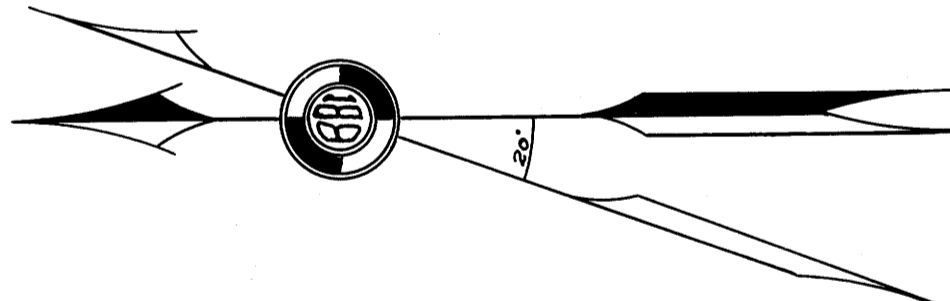
DEDICATION.

Douglas County, OREGON, does by these presents plat and establish said real property as and by the name of FAIR OAKS CEMETERY and it does hereby declare the annexed plat a true and correct plat, that the blocks and lots conform to their wish and they hereby dedicate to the Public use forever the roadways and alleys shown on said plat.
