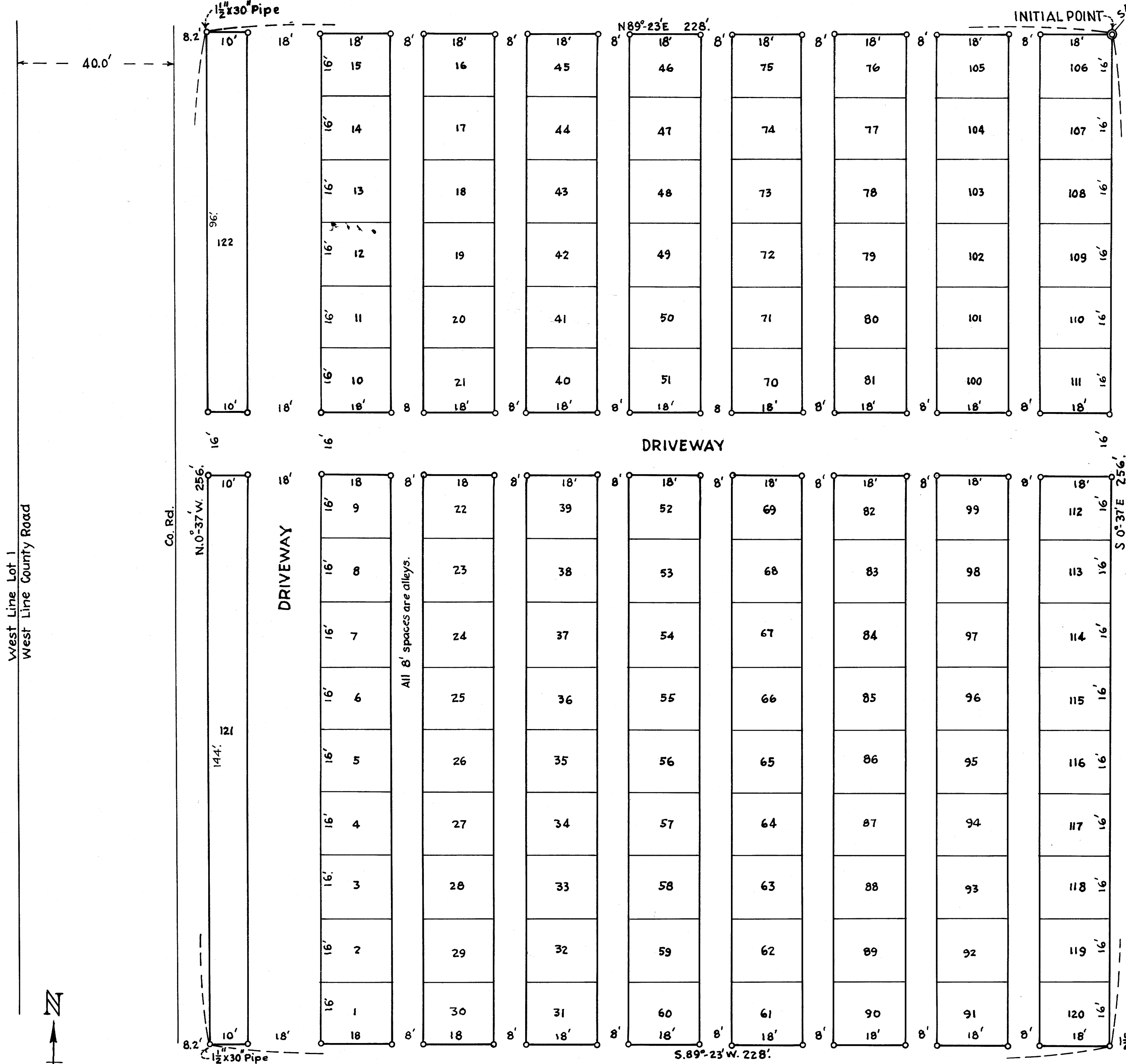


Note: Pipe are driven at the corners of each lot. All 8' spaces are alleys.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I, Arthur Boyer, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have surveyed the land representd on the annexed and plat of Eden Cemetery, of Elgarose, Douglas County, Oregon, that the Survey hereof is, in all respects, correct and true and that I have set a monument indicating the Initial Point of such survey and that said monument is a 3' x 36' iron pipe which is the North East corner of said Eden Cemetery, said Initial Point being S.40° 07' W. 595.8 ft. from the Section Corner common to Sections 35 & 36, T.26 S.; R.7 W. and Sections 2 & 3, T.27 S.; R.7 W.; W.M., said Initial Point being the N.E. corner of said Cemetery, and that the aforesaid land surveyed by me is more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the aforesaid Initial Point, thence S.0° 37' E. 256.0 ft. to a 1 1/2' x 30' pipe, thence S.89° 23' W. 228.0 ft. to a 1 1/2' x 30' pipe, thence N.0° 37' W. 256.0 ft. to a 1 1/2' x 30' pipe, thence N.89° 23' E. 228.0 ft. to the place of beginning, all the above in Lot 4 Eden Orchards, in Sec. 2, T.27 S.; R.7 W.; Willamette Meridian and that the boundaries of said plat, known as Eden Cemetery, are correct and that the subdivisions contained therein are true and correct and in conformity with the figures shown.
