I Arthur Boyer being first duly sworn - depose and say: I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat and I hereby certify that the following is a true and correct description thereof, to wit:

Beginning at a 2 inch iron pipe, from which the Initial Monument for the SOUTH UMPQUA MASONIC CEMETERY bears N. 89° 29' E - 62.0 ft., the location of said Initial Monument being N. 44° 52' E - 1665.4 ft. from the quarter section corner betw. sections 27 and 28, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W.M.
