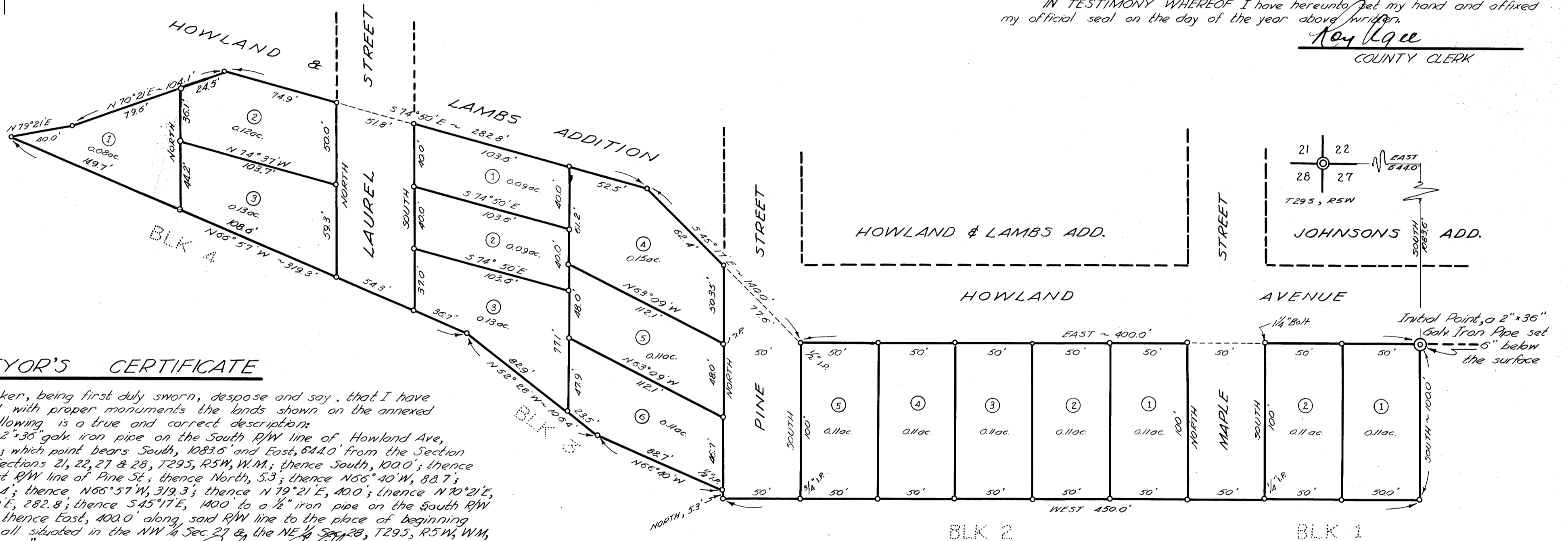
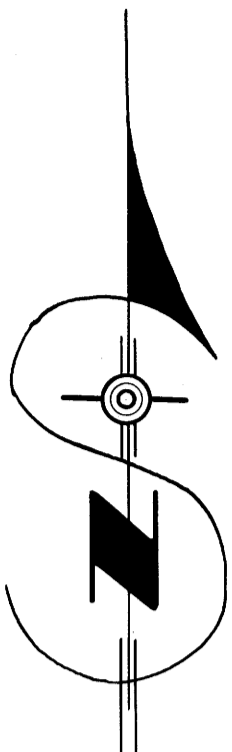
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Richard R. Ecker, being first duly sworn, depose and say, that I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description:

"Beginning at a 2"x36" galv iron pipe on the South R/W line of Howland Ave, Town of Myrtle Creek; which point bears South, 1083.6' and East, 644.0' from the Section corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 & 28, T29S, R5W, W.M.; thence South, 100.0'; thence West, 450.0' to the West R/W line of Pine St; thence North, 5.3'; thence N66°40'W, 88.7'; thence N52°28'W, 106.4'; thence N66°57'W, 319.3'; thence N79°21'E, 40.0'; thence N70°21'E, 104.1'; thence S74°50'E, 282.8'; thence S45°17'E, 140.0' to a 1/2" iron pipe on the South R/W line of Howland Ave; thence East, 400.0' along said R/W line to the place of beginning containing 2.15 acres all situated in the NW 1/4 Sec. 27 & the NE 1/4 Sec. 28, T29S, R5W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon."
