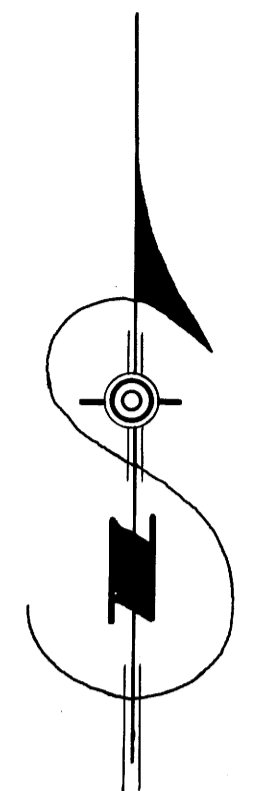
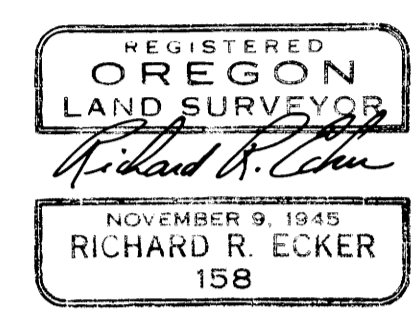

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Richard R. Ecker, being first duly sworn, depose and say, that I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description:

Beginning at a 2" x 35" galvanized iron pipe on the southwesterly R/W line of Wall St., City of Canyonville, Douglas Co., Oregon; which point bears S30°E, 30.0' and S00°W, 23.0' from the original monument at the intersection of the center lines of First and Wall Sts. in said city; thence N30°W, 517.9' along said R/W line; thence S01°W, 270.8' to a point where said bearing intersects cemetery property line; thence S11°E, 60.1' to the Southeast corner of said cemetery; thence S70°15'W, 257.4'; thence N11°W, 128.0'; thence S70°15'W, 289.7' to a point on the Graham property line; thence S17°40'E, 482.3' along said Graham property line to a 2" axle housing at the Southeast corner of said Graham property; thence N05°45'E, 326.8'; thence S30°E, 182.3'; thence N00°E, 577.7' to the place of beginning containing 9.90 acres all situated in Sec 34, T30S, R5W, W.M., Douglas Co., City of Canyonville, Oregon.

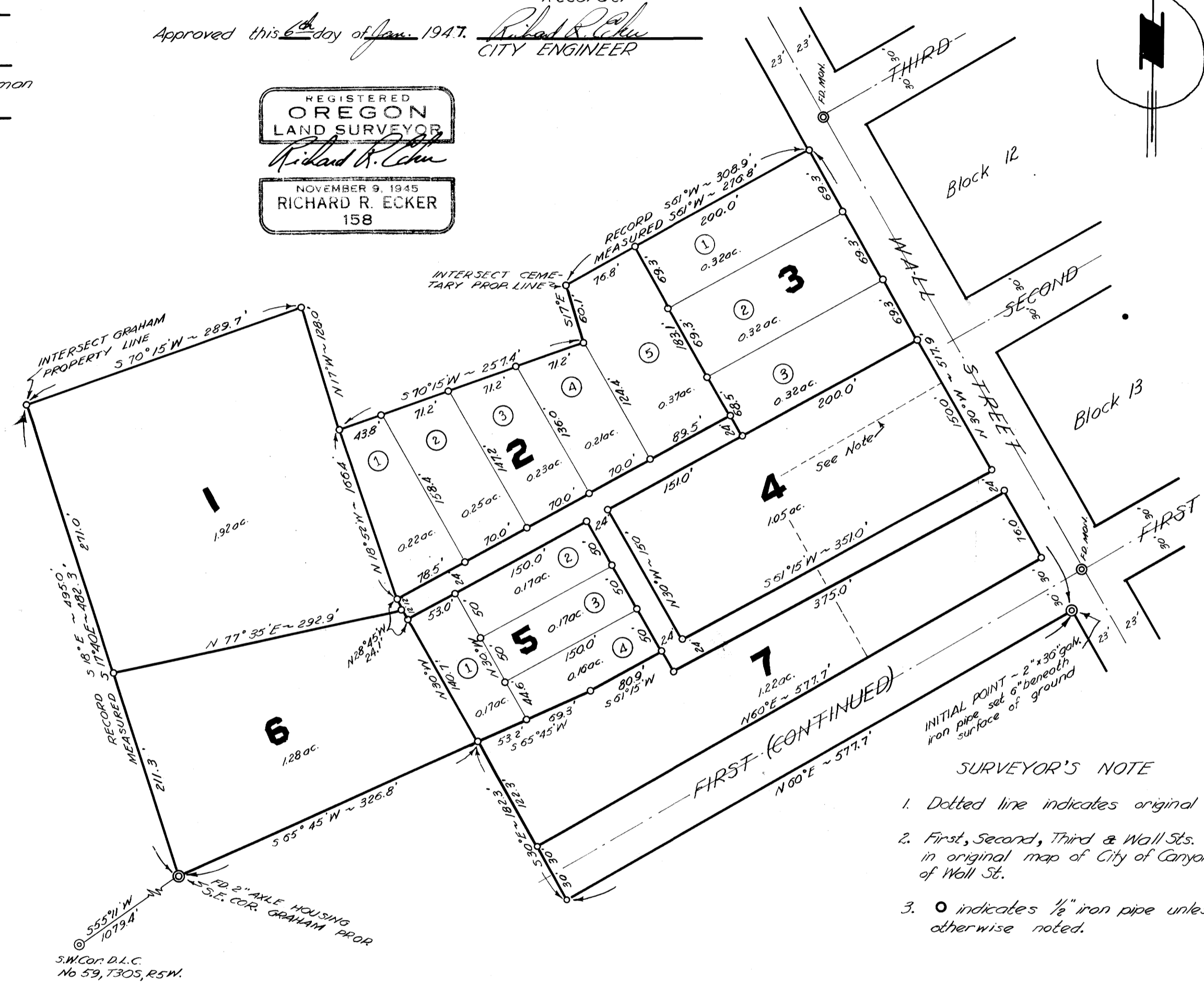
