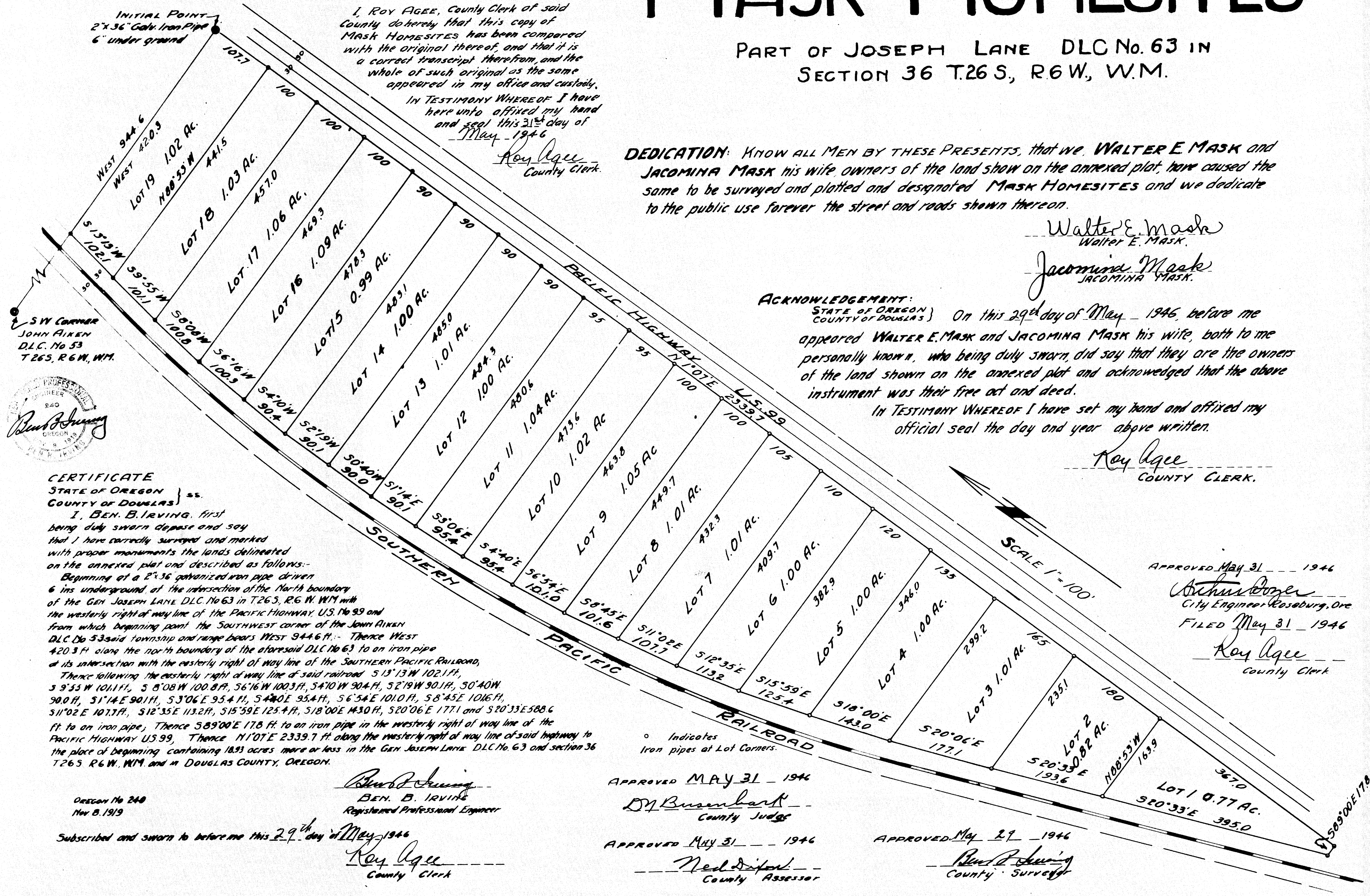

I, BEN. B. IRVING, first being duly sworn depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands delineated on the annexed plat and described as follows:-
Beginning at a 2"x36" galvanized iron pipe driven 6 ins underground at the intersection of the North boundary of the Gen. JOSEPH LANE DLC No. 63 in T.26 S., R.6 W., W.M. with the westerly right of way line of the Pacific Highway, U.S. No. 99 and from which beginning point the Southwest corner of the JOHN AIKEN DLC No. 53 said township and range bears WEST 944.6 ft.
