CERTIFICATE of SURVEYOR

I, Richard R. Ecker, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:
Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2"x36" galv. iron pipe set 6' underground on the North-Row-Line of a County Road, from which the South 1/4 cor. of Sec. 22, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M., Douglas County, Ore. bears S 44° 27' W - 453.7 ft., thence running N 33° 32' W - 337.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe on the East Row-Line of the County Road No 5, thence along said Row-Line of said County Road: N 40° 49' E - 78.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe, thence N 34° 31' E - 165.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe, thence N 30° 58' E - 475.3 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence leaving said Row-Line of said County Road No 5 and running S 0° 10' W - 835.6 ft. to a 1" iron pipe on the North Row-Line of the County Road first mentioned above, thence along said Row-Line of same road S 76° 33' W - 206.1 ft. to the Point of Beginning; all in Sec. 22, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M., in Douglas County, Oregon.

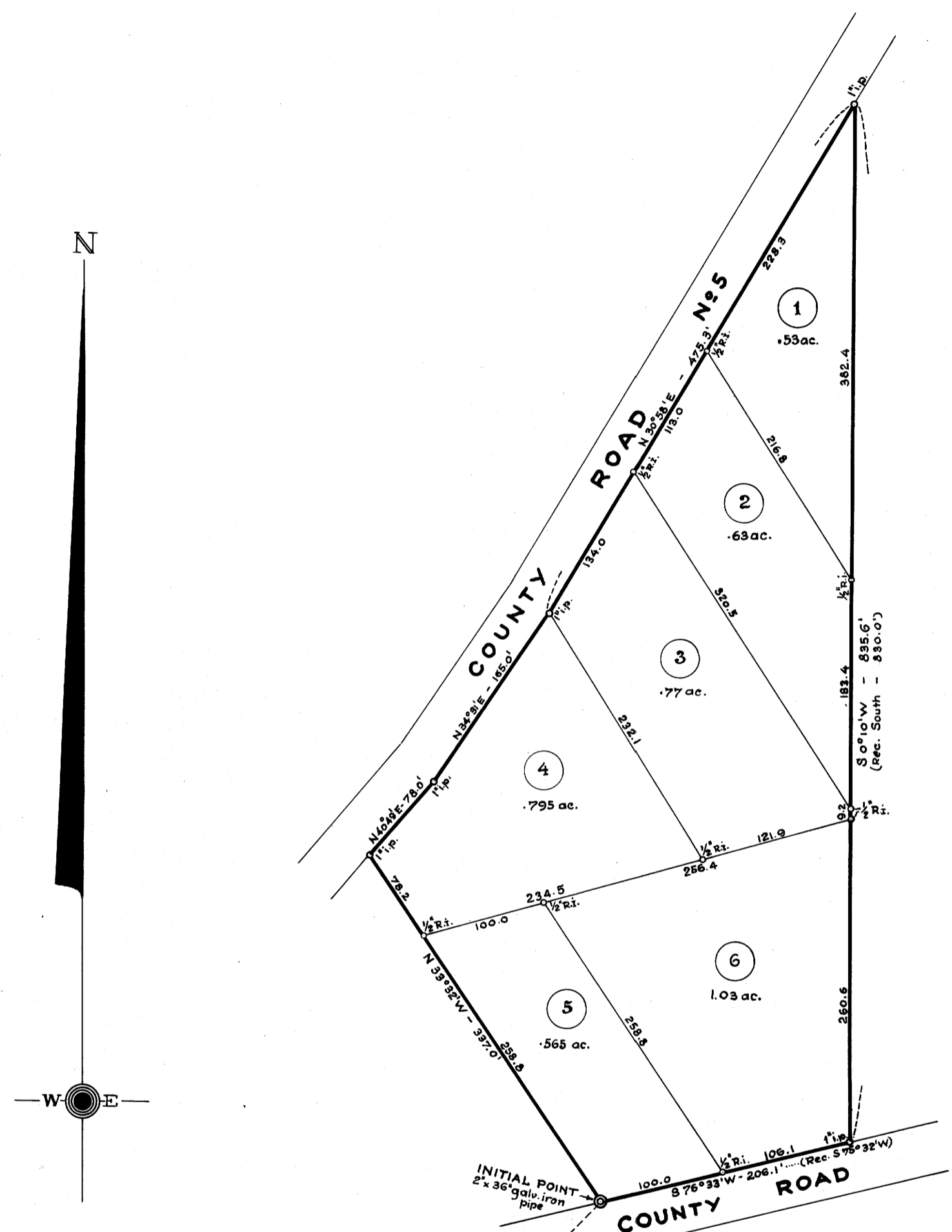
