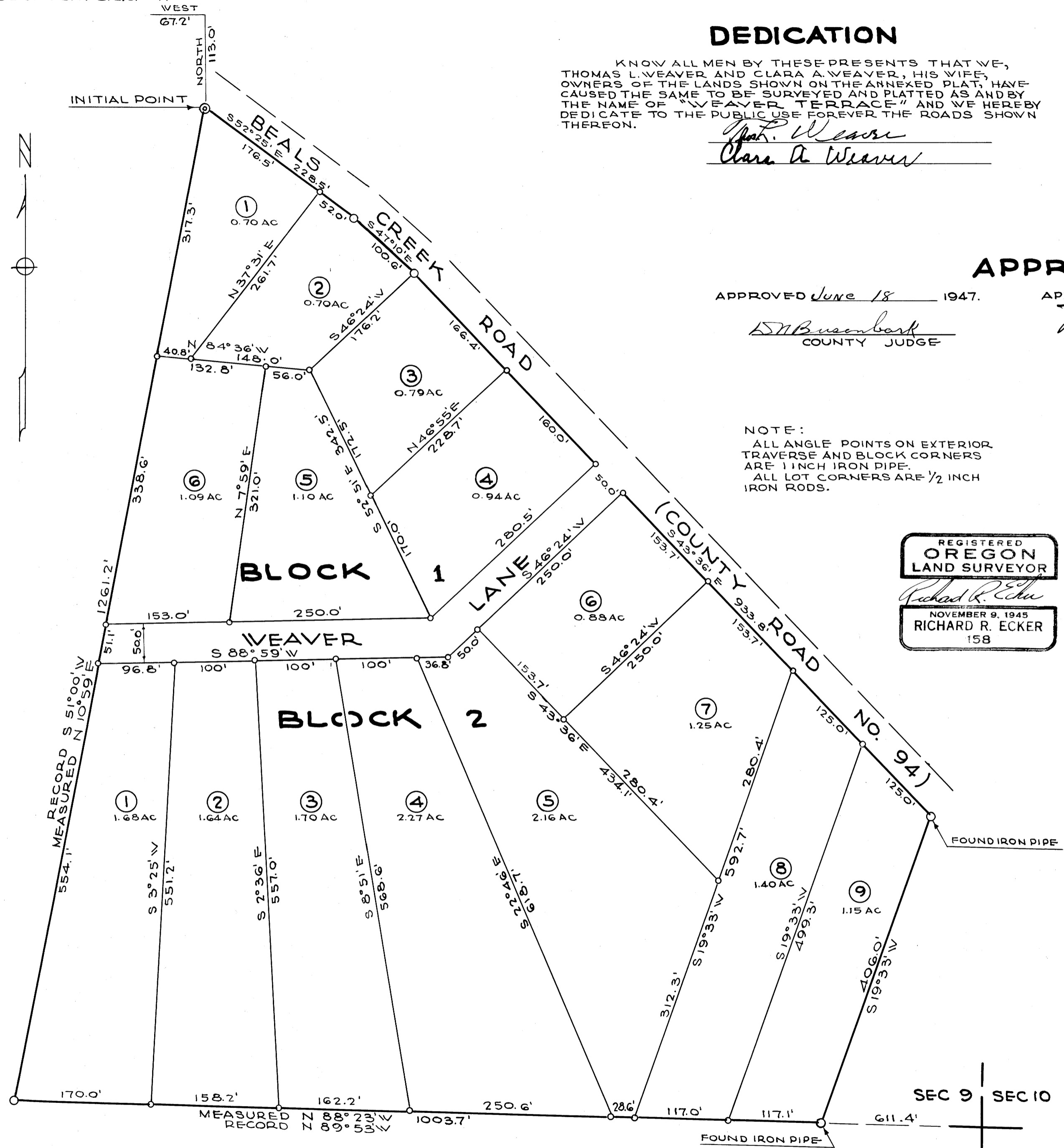

I, RICHARD R. ECKER, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, DEPOSE AND SAY, THAT I HAVE CORRECTLY SURVEYED AND MARKED WITH PROPER MONUMENTS THE LANDS SHOWN ON THE ANNEXED PLAT OF WHICH THE FOLLOWING IS A TRUE AND CORRECT DESCRIPTION, TO WIT:
