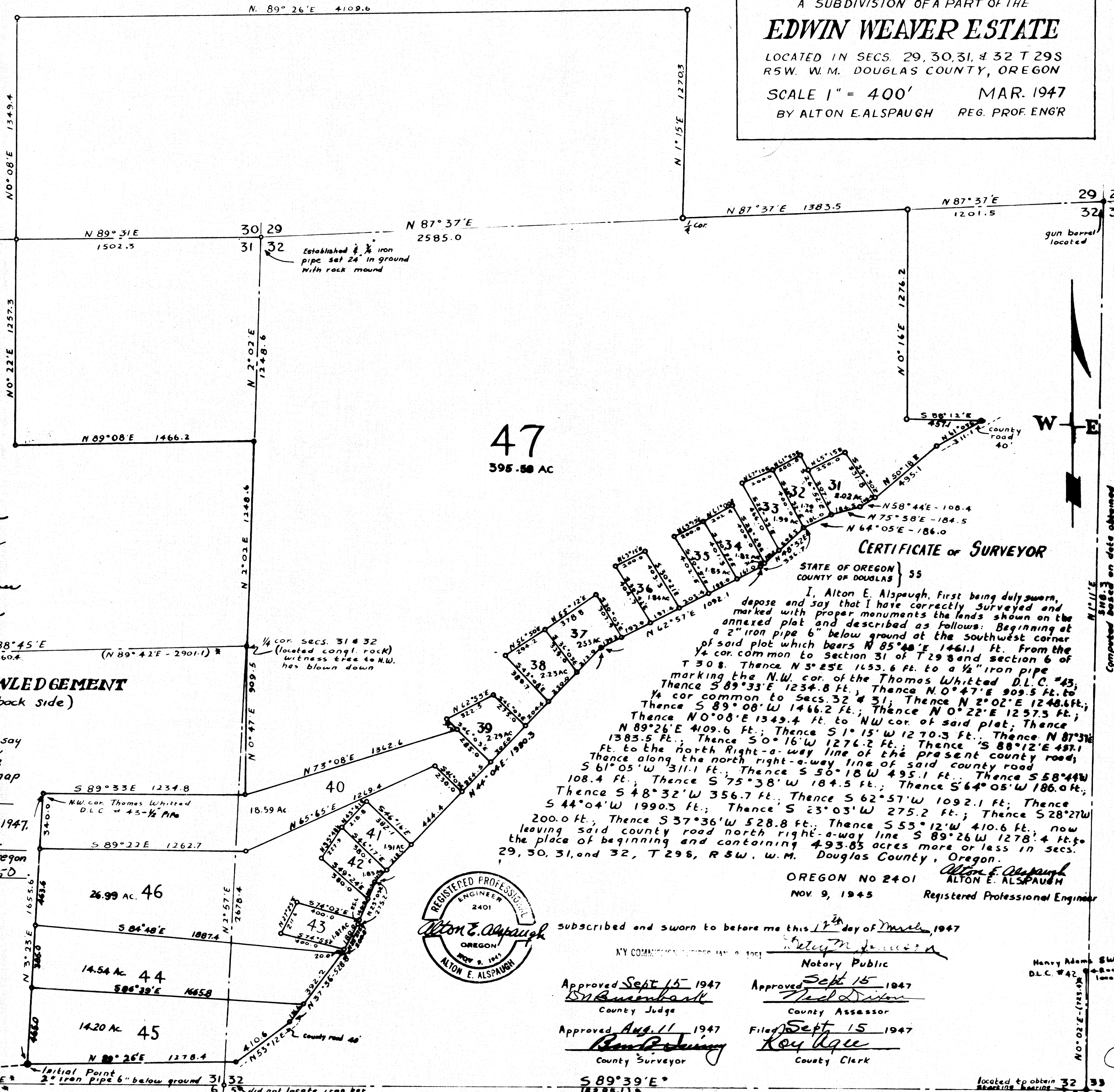

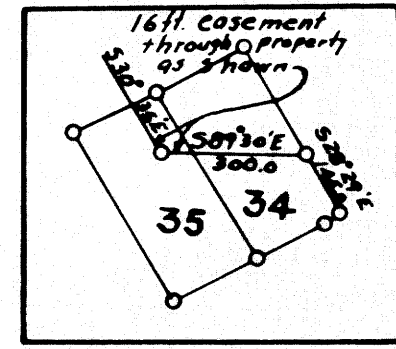
PLAT B

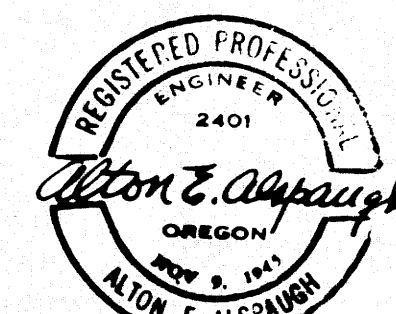

CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

Alspaugh, first being duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands shown on the annexed plot and described as follows: Beginning at a 2" iron pipe 6" below ground at the southwest corner of said plot which bears N 85° 48' E 1461.1 ft. from the 1/4 cor. common to Section 31 of T 29 S and section 6 of T 30 S. Thence N 5° 25' E 1653.6 ft. to a 1/2" iron pipe marking the N.W. cor. of the Thomas Whitted D.L.C. #43.
