### CERTIFICATE of SURVEYOR

I, Richard R. Ecker, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have surveyed and correctly marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description - to wit: Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2 3/8 gal. iron pipe set 6" underground at the southerly R/W line of E. Fifth St., which point bears: N 64° 11' W - 128.0 ft. from the "X in Stone Monument" at intersection of center-lines of Wall and First Sts. and: N 2° 36' E - 1610.4 ft. from the S.W. cor. of the Joseph Roberts D.L.C.#59 - T.30S., R.5W., W.M., in Douglas County, Ore.; thence leaving said R/W line and running S 17° 00' E - 350.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence S 72° 30' W - 196.9 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence N 17° 30' W - 25.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence S 72° 30' W - 125.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence N 17° 30' W - 75.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence S 72° 30' W - 75.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe; thence N 17° 30' W - 250.0 ft. to a 1" iron pipe on the said southerly R/W line of E. Fifth St.; thence along said R/W line N 72° 30' E - 4000.0 ft. to the Point of Beginning; all in Sec. 34, T.30S., R.5W., W.M., in Douglas County, Ore. - and containing 2.96 ac. ± including dedicated streets.

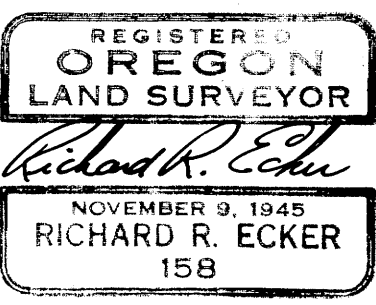

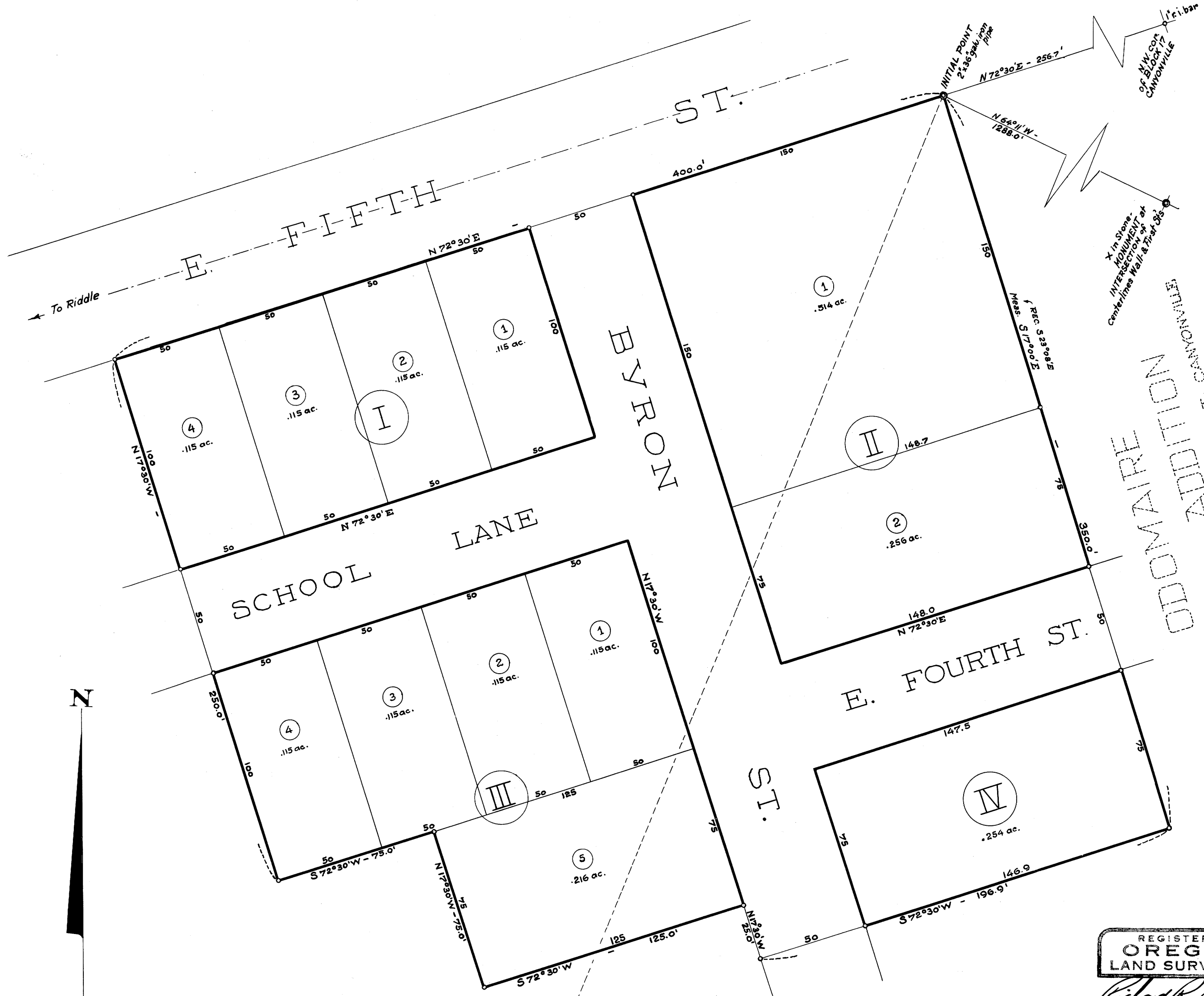
