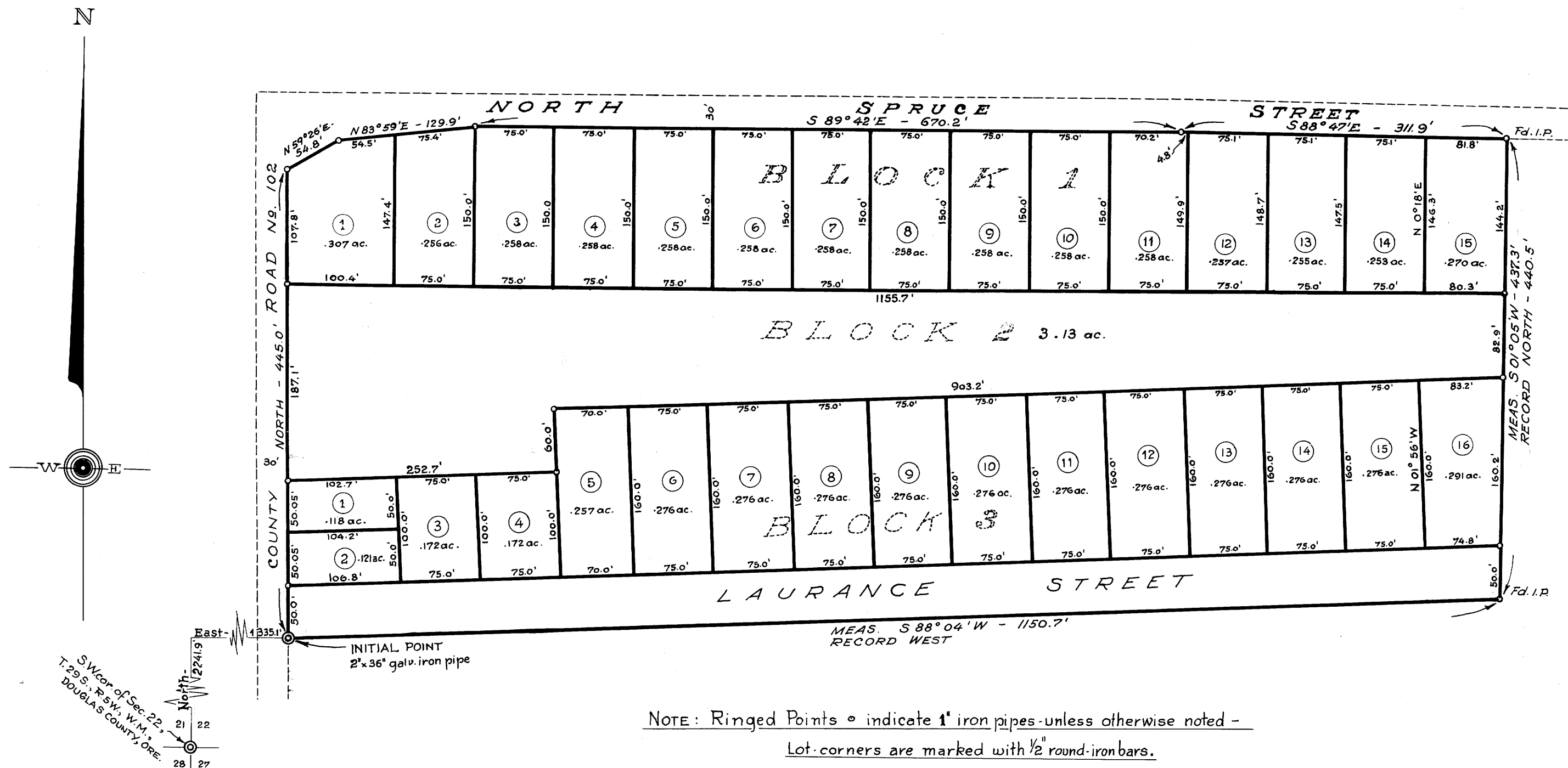

Lot corners are marked with 1/2" round iron bars.

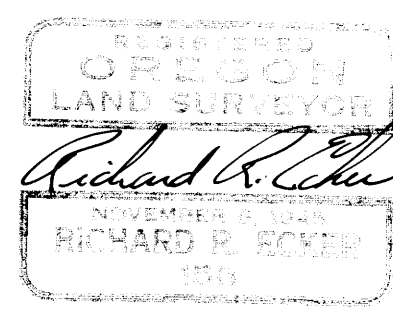
## CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

I, Richard R. Ecker, being first duly sworn depose and say, that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:  
Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2"x36" galv. iron pipe 6" underground on the East R/W Line of the County Road No. 102, which point bears North-2241.9 ft. and East-1335.1 ft. from the Sec. cor common to Sec's 21, 22, 27 & 28, T.29 S., R.5 W., W.M., Douglas County, Ore., thence along said R/W line North-445.0 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N59°26'E - 54.8 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N83°59'E - 129.9 ft. to an iron pipe on the South R/W Line of North Spruce Street; thence along said R/W line S89°42'E - 670.2 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S88°47'E - 311.9 ft. to an iron pipe; thence leaving said R/W line and running S1°05'W - 437.3 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S88°04'W - 1150.7 ft. to the Point of Beginning; all in Sec. 22, T.29 S., R.5 W., W.M., in Douglas County, Ore., and containing 12.25 acs. more or less.
